I responded to 1500 N Orange Ave #108 for a suspicious death of a child. The child had been taken by ambulance to Sarasota Memorial Hospital around 1200 hours. The circumstances to the death were suspicious. The child had a body temperature of 106 degrees when she arrived at the hospital and signs of rigor mortis had set in already.

I conducted an audio recorded interview with the mother, Valeria Mendoza. She stated her ex-boyfriend (daughter's father) picked A.M. up at approximately 0600 hours. She said he takes her on Sunday mornings for breakfast. She said he doesn't usually come this early but he had been at his cousin's house in the same complex so he decided to take her early so he didn't have to come back. Valeria said Uriel called her at before noon to tell her A.M. was not responding. Valeria said she rushed to his house and called 911 on her way. She got to Uriel's house and found her daughter on his bed. She was unresponsive and not breathing. She brought her to the front of the house and that is when the paramedics arrived on scene. She said Uriel is a great father.


I then conducted an audio recorded interview with Uriel at the hospital. Officer Blanco translated for me this interview. Uriel first said he found A.M. in the bed warm to the touch and called 911 and Valeria. Officer Blanco then read Uriel his Miranda Rights in Spanish

Uriel signed consent to search for his residence and his car. The car was transported to the police station for processing. Criminalistics Supervisor Churchill collected A.M.s clothes, diaper, and child's cup of milk from Ureil's bedroom.

Uriel was transported to the SSO jail without incident.


