As part of his session, Dillard provided information around careers in broadcast journalism, in particular non-commercial radio journalism.  On October 20, 2011, Correspondent Rick Fredericksen served as a guest presenter at Drake University radio journalism class. During his presentation, Fredericksen shared components of the IPR website, pointing out particular stories he had produced, and then offering time for critique of his presentation style. Fredericksen also discussed career opportunities in public radio.  On October 21, 2011, News Director Jonathan Ahl, Correspondent Jeneane Beck, and Correspondent Rob Dillard led community members on a tour of the studios, discussing the

components required to produce a daily newscast, story packaging, and the decision-making process around what issues become stories.

Beginning in late 2011 and continuing into 2012, the African American Museum of Iowa has included a segment around education from Correspondent Rob Dillard's series "Being African American in Iowa" as part of an exhibit highlighting the African American experience in Iowa.

On October 31, 2011, Senior Development Officer for Major Gifts Troy Vogel served as a panelist for the University of Northern Iowa College of Business Administration's "Professional Readiness Program." During the event, Vogel provided information around employer professional expectations and career opportunities that a student may look into upon receiving their business degree.

On March 9, 2012, Reporter John Pemble led Drake University's Society of Professional Journalists on a tour of the studios. During the tour, Pemble discussed methods for developing news stories, recording and broadcasting in the studios, and spoke about the skills necessary for a career broadcasting.

(v) Internship Program -

In two years' time: Establishment of an internship program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment

WOI continued its internship program, offering opportunities in the following departments: traffic, operations, communications, and news reporting.

To share one success story, in the News department a student was given the opportunity to serve in a year-long intern role, providing daily news cast segments, pitching story ideas, collecting research and audio, recording script, and editing and packaging long-form stories reviewed and edited by the News Director. Once the stories met with the editing standards, the intern's long-form reports were aired as well. Additionally, the intern served as a back-up morning and afternoon newsmagazine host, working and collaborating with reporters and hosts across the state to successfully broadcast the magazines. Upon conclusion of their internship, this individual was immediately hired at a public radio station in Colorado.

In the past year 33 students participated in the internship program.

#### (viii) Employee Training -

In two years' time: Establishment of training programs designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher level positions

WOI continues to provide professional growth training opportunities for station personnel. Past training opportunities included:

- November 10, 2011: Morning Edition Host Sarah McCammon participated in the Public Radio Program Directors Inc. webinar titled "Hostiness w/Marilyn Pittman."
   During the training, she learned about host presentation styles and methodologies.
- December 8, 2011: Correspondent Joyce Russell, Reporter John Pemble, and Morning Edition Host Sarah McCammon participated in the Public Radio News Directors Inc. webinar titled "10 Sites Every Journalist Should Know." During the training, they learned of ten reliable resource sites that reporters may utilize to track data, store ideas and stories, and become more familiar with social media.
- March 1, 2012: Morning Edition Host Sarah McCammon and Reporter John Pemble
  participated in the Public Radio News Directors Inc. webinar titled "Interested in
  getting more investigative reporting on your airwaves?" The presentation discussed
  starting an investigative team, benefiting from peers in-depth work, managing an
  investigative partnership, and support from leadership in the investigative project.
- March 15, 2012: Reporter John Pemble participated in the Public Radio News
  Directors Inc. webinar titled "If You Can't Beat 'em, Partner With 'em." The webinar
  shared information around collaboration with previously defined competitors,
  furthering funding and generating new opportunities while better using technology to
  connect with peers.
- May 22, 2012: *Morning Edition* Host Sarah McCammon participated in the Public Radio Program Directors Association webinar around "Creative Features on a Deadline with Planet Money's Robert Smith." During the webinar, McCammon learned new approaches on how to package and present features stories.
