KSUI/WSUI has engaged in the following outreach activities as covered during the term of this report:

(i) Job Fair Participation – In two years' time: Participation in at least four job fairs by station personnel who have substantial responsibility in the making of hiring decisions	KSUI/WSUI participated in the September 16, 2013 University of Northern Iowa career fair, presenting professional opportunities in public radio and raising general awareness of the organization among young professionals. KSUI/WSUI participated in the September 26, 2013 University of Iowa career fair, presenting professional opportunities in public radio and raising general awareness of the organization among young professionals.		
(iv) Participation in community group events – In two years' time: Participation in at least four events sponsored by organizations representing groups present in the community interested in broadcast employment issues, including conventions, career days, workshops, and similar activities	On April 9, 2013, <i>River to River</i> host Ben Kieffer moderated a screening of "The Waiting Room," which was previously discussed on his show. This event, which was presented by the University of Iowa College of Medicine, was open to the general public and included discussion on both the movie and the medium used by the filmmakers – both video and the locally hosted talk show, which opened discussion around issues the media face, including employment opportunities.		
(v) Internship Program – In two years' time: Establishment of an internship program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment	KSUI/WSUI continued its internship program, offering opportunities in talk show production and underwriting sales. To highlight an internship from this past year, in the talk show department KSUI/WSUI offered a student the opportunity to research possible talk shows, research the background of and call on prospective guests, storyboard and prepare main components of shows, and monitor callers during live shows. This recent graduate applied for and earned a position with the organization from a pool of more than 30 other candidates.		

(v) Internship Program (Continued) –	In the past year 6 students participated in the internship program.		
(viii) Employee Training – In two years' time: Establishment of training programs designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher level positions	 KSUI/WSUI continues to provide professional growth training opportunities for station personnel. Past training opportunities included: November 16 and 17, 2012: Weekend Edition host Julie Englander and Correspondent Dean Borg participated in News training focused on individual and departmental needs and aspirations, developing skills to assist the employees in developing their skillset in a way that would allow them to grow within the organization and help the department move forward strategically. March 19, 2013: Java Blend host Ben Kieffer and Student Producer Kendall McCabe participated in website training focused on how to post and deliver content on the organization's website. The training reviewed and discussed strategies for posting content so that it would be better geared to be clicked into and viewed by online viewers. May 20, 2013: River to River host Ben Kieffer, Talk of lowa host Charity Nebbe, talk show producers Ben Stanton, Emily Woodbury, Sarah Boden, and Dennis Reese, and Executive producer of Talk Shows Katherine Perkins visited WBEZ in Chicago. During their field visit they observed the station's talk show The Morning Shift, participated in talk show team meetings, and watched as show ideas were storyboarded and developed. The ideas were brought back and implemented among the talk show team, positively impacting the daily presentation of the shows and providing additional skills for the individual members of the team. 		

NOTE: The station employment unit is located in a market with a population of fewer than 250,000, and therefore is required to complete two long-term outreach activities every two years.
