WOI has engaged in the following outreach activities as covered during the term of this report:

(i) Job Fair Participation – In two years' time: Participation in at least four job fairs by station personnel who have substantial responsibility in the making of hiring decisions	WOI-AM/FM participated in the September 16, 2013 University of Northern Iowa career fair, presenting professional opportunities in public radio and raising general awareness of the organization among young professionals. WOI-AM/FM participated in the September 26, 2013 University of Iowa career fair, presenting professional opportunities in public radio and raising general awareness of the organization among young professionals.		
(iv) Participation in community group events – In two years' time: Participation in at least four events sponsored by organizations representing groups present in the community interested in broadcast employment issues, including conventions, career days, workshops, and similar activities	On October 11, 2012, Correspondent Rick Fredericksen served as a guest presenter at a Drake University radio journalism class. During his presentation, Fredericksen shared components of the IPR website, pointing out particular stories he had produced, and then offering time for critique of his presentation style. Fredericksen also discussed his career in media as well as career opportunities in public radio. On November 29, 2012, Correspondent Rob Dillard served as a guest presenter at Central College's Writers Reading series. During the presentation Dillard played snippets of his writing as broadcast on air, discussed the challenges of writing for radio as opposed to print, and discussed writing careers and careers in public media. On April 16, 2013, <i>Morning Edition</i> host Sarah McCammon served as a guest presenter for Des Moines Area Community College's "Urban Vibe" (campus newspaper) staff. She discussed journalism and reporting and also discussed similarities and differences in print vs. radio reporting and print/radio careers.		

(iv) Participation in community group events (Continued) –	On May 5, 2013, Correspondent Rob Dillard spoke to a group of 50 community citizens at Grace Lutheran Church in Des Moines. As part of his presentation, Dillard discussed the organization and public media in general.
In two years' time: Participation in at least four events sponsored by organizations representing groups present in the community interested in broadcast employment issues, including conventions, career days, workshops, and similar activities	On July 16, 2013, Correspondent Rob Dillard spoke with a delegation of Chinese journalists at the Iowa Sister States office.
(v) Internship Program – In two years' time: Establishment of an internship program designed to assist members of the community to acquire skills needed for broadcast employment	WOI continued its internship program, offering opportunities in the following departments: traffic, operations, communications, and news reporting. To share one success story, in the Communications department a student was given the opportunity to provide support to both the Communications and Underwriting divisions, supporting efforts around building proposals, working with clients, and supporting events and outreach efforts. Upon graduation that student applied for an open position with the organization and was selected for the position due to best meeting the needs of the position. In the past year 22 students participated in the internship program.
(viii) Employee Training – In two years' time: Establishment of training programs designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills that could qualify them for higher level positions	 WOI continues to provide professional growth training opportunities for station personnel. Past training opportunities included: November 16 and 17, 2012: Correspondents Joyce Russell, Rob Dillard, Clay Masters, and Rick Fredericksen as well as Morning Edition host Sarah McCammon and reporters John Pemble and Amy Mayer participated in News training focused on individual and departmental needs and aspirations, developing skills to assist the employees in developing their skillset in a way that would allow them to grow within the organization and help the department move forward strategically.

NOTE: The station employment unit is located in a market with a population of fewer than 250,000, and therefore is required to complete two long-term outreach activities every two years.
