The paid summer internship program provides a work-based learning experience for qualified high school students enrolled in San Francisco Unified School District CTE Pathways. Summer internships provide students with the opportunity to take what they learn during the school year and apply it to the real world. Interns report to their internship 20 hours a week over six weeks in industries such as Business, Construction, Education, Marketing, Technology, Law, Hospitality, Transportation, and much more. These experiences help students develop personal and professional skills while attaining success in academia and in the workforce.
