In the spirit of mutual cooperation, the Chief Academic Officers (i.e., Provosts) of the universities comprising the Southeastern Conference (SEC) enter into this agreement to develop and encourage education abroad opportunities for all SEC students by making applicable programs widely available and accessible. Each SEC university's chief international officer and/or education abroad director will be responsible for implementing this agreement, which will ensure the following:

1. Qualified, degree-seeking students at any SEC university may apply to designated faculty-led education abroad programs at any other SEC university on a space-available basis;
2. Students enrolled in an SEC university will be charged rates and/or program fees equivalent to those charged resident students at the university delivering the education abroad program. (NOTE: All students will be subject to the same rates and/or program fees at Vanderbilt University.);
3. A representative from each university will be designated as a contact regarding this agreement and he or she will be responsible for identifying available programs and notifying other SEC universities accordingly; and
4. University education abroad program offerings will be discussed regularly.

This SEC Cooperative Education Abroad Agreement will continue indefinitely. However, any SEC member university may withdraw from this agreement by notice to the other universities, provided any programs in progress at the time of withdrawal are not affected thereby. In addition, this agreement may be amended or terminated by majority approval of the Chief Academic Officers.
