FEEDING.

***The feed within the food receptacle for the coatimundi appeared to be caked into clumps with portions of the food having a fuzzy-like white discoloration on top of some of the food. This was currently the only feed available for the animal. According to the licensee, the coatimundi was fed a dry kibble dog food and the feeder was cleaned every couple of weeks. It appeared that the coatimundi would not be able to eat the food within the self-feeder without eating the contaminated food. The animal was observed eating the food from the top of the self-feeder which is where the abnormal appearing food was located. Contaminated food can decrease the animal's acceptance of the food and can increase the risk of disease and health hazards. The licensee needs to remove the current caked and moldy-like feed. The licensee needs to establish and maintain a program to ensure that food is wholesome, palatable, free from contamination and that there is no molding, deterioration and/or caking of feed at all times.
