(d) Perimeter fence.

\*\*\*There was a large tree that had fallen over and several large limbs had landed across the top of the perimeter fence on the south side of the facility near the tigers' and liger's enclosure. The limbs had pushed down the top of the fence and were lying across the top. These limbs could provide ramp-like access over the top of this secondary containment structure. The perimeter fence must be constructed so that it protects the animals in the facility by functioning as a secondary containment system for the animals in the facility. The perimeter fence must also be of sufficient height to keep animals and unauthorized persons out. The licensee must remove the fallen tree from the fence and ensure that the perimeter fence is constructed and maintained so that it can function as a secondary containment system for the animals in the facility at all times.

The inspection and exit interview were conducted with Dr. Erika Leisner (VMO), Stephanie Osborne (ACI) and the licensee.
