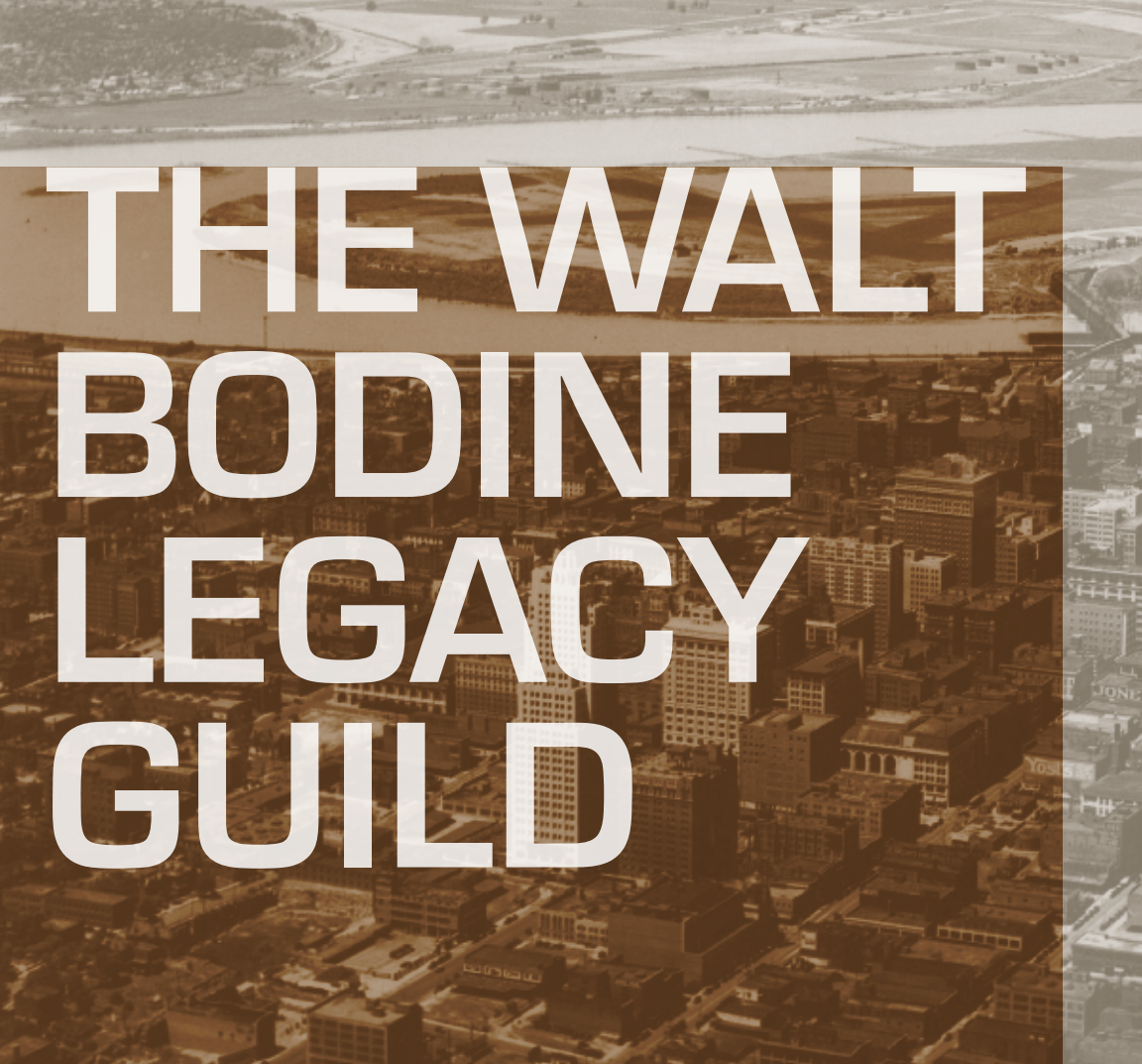

## There are several ways to give.
