

Welcome Potential KDLL Board Member!

KDLL's Board plays a vital role in the decision-making of the station. Board members' energy and commitment help guide our community radio station into the future. If you are familiar with KDLL and share our vision of quality, diverse community radio, you could be just the person we're looking for.

The KDLL Board consists of up to nine members who are elected by the KDLL membership (members who have donated within a year). Board terms run from January to January for three years, whereupon board members may choose to run for reelection. Board members may not have been employees of KDLL in the previous 12 months.

We seek a diversity of experiences and backgrounds. Board members must be a resident of the central Kenai Peninsula and be a KDLL member for at least a year. Board members are required to continue annual membership throughout their term. All board members should exhibit good listening skills, be respectful of others' opinions and endorse KDLL's mission. Board members work in a variety of areas, including long-range planning, fundraising, marketing, fiscal responsibility, outreach and technology. While we are interested in specific skills that contribute to success in these areas, it is equally important that board members be enthusiastic, thoughtful, have a positive attitude and be willing to volunteer their time.

Board members must attend monthly meetings, unless they request and are granted an absence in advance, and attend fund-raisers, functions, annual meetings and other meetings/events in which Board participation is requested.

Process:

1. Familiarize yourself with the KDLL bylaws and other documents contained in the [Transparency Report on the website](#).
2. Complete and submit a board member application **by 5 p.m. Dec. 12, 2017**.

3. Applications will be reviewed by a nominating committee consisting of current board members. Applicants may be contacted for further information. Qualified applicants will be submitted for a vote by the KDLL membership via a mailed ballot. Completed ballots must be received by 5 p.m. Jan. 26. Newly elected board members must sign an agreement letter outlining board roles and responsibilities. New board members will be announced at the annual meeting, Jan. 27, 2018.
