This quick and easy pillowcase allows you to make a pillow case for your pillow to match the throw or quilt or for any holiday, season or special interest. You will choose three fabrics or colors; one each for the body, accent and cuff. The magic is the cuff, body and accent all have a finished edge. These will make great gifts for your friends and family. You may want several for extra pillows for your bed, outdoor swing or rocker.

Requirements	Fabric	
	Standard/Queen	King
Cuff	8"	10"
	2"	2"
Body	27"	30"

WOF = Width of Fabric

7. Sew along the entire length of the roll.
8. Now turn the noodle inside out.
9. Press the cuff and accent piece towards the cuff.
10. Fold in half placing the unfinished side of the pillow case together and square. Trim off excess fabric and selvages.
11. Place the RIGHT sides of the case together and pin along the raw edges. Starting with the cuff, stitch the side and bottom sides to complete the case with a 1/2" seam. The inside seams can also be serged to give a nice finished edge.

1. Lay the cuff out lengthwise (42" or 44" WOF) RIGHT side up.
2. Fold accent piece in half lengthwise, RIGHT sides together, (the accent will now be 1" wide by WOF); press.
3. Place the folded accent piece at the top of the cuff, raw edges placed together.
4. Starting at the cut edge with the WRONG side up, roll the body fabric into a tight noodle.
5. Center the rolled noodle on top (RIGHT side down) of the cuff and accent pieces.
6. Now bring the opposite end of the cut edge of the cuff up around the rolled noodle. Pin all raw edges together to make one 1/2" seam.
