WONDERS OF MEXICO

Wonders of Mexico, a three-part series, showcases the country's natural fiesta of color and life, born out of its unique combination of geology, geography, and weather. Told through the lives of wildlife and people, this is the definitive story of Mexico.



In Mexico's far south lies an unusual peninsula: the Yucatan. Swathed in a forest covering 50,000 square miles, this land was once ruled by the mighty Maya civilization. This immense peninsula is actually a giant slab of porous limestone, meaning water is quickly sucked underground. For half the year virtually no rain falls.

The ruins and ancient cultivated gardens of the spectacular Maya temple of Calakmul was once home to over 50,000 people. But how did such a great civilization arise without a river? Don Roque, a mayan descendent, reveals the key to the success of his ancient ancestors: the natural well or cenote. In his garden is one of 8,000 cenotes scattered across the peninsula.

The massive underground network of rivers and caves provide the perfect roosting habitat for bats. None are more dramatic than "El Volcan de los Murcielagos"—the bat volcano, that erupts every evening with more than 3 million bats.

Like any rivers, the Yucatan's underground rivers flow towards the sea. At the coast, a colony of Caribbean flamingos raises their 15,000 new chicks. With so much food, these flamingos grow more colorful than any of their kind.

Mexico is dominated by the Sierra Madre, or "Mother Mountains." The grandest mountain vistas of all are found in the north-west. The Copper Canyon covers 25,000 square miles and is home to the Rarámuri. To navigate the difficult terrain, they've become remarkable long distance runners.

In the ancient Sierra Gorda Mountains, the temperate and tropical collide. Here we find the most beguiling of flowers: orchids. To spread their pollen they rely on the mesmerizing orchid bee.

Central Mexico is one of the most volcanic places on Earth, with more than 20 active volcanoes. Their ash helps fertilize the soils, making this one of the most productive regions of the country. Perhaps the most famous mountain product is tequila, made from the blue agave plant. We meet a 16-year-old agave farmer, a jimador.

Some of Mexico's mountain worlds are so inviting they compel creatures to journey thousands of miles to reach them. Every year millions of monarch butterflies overwinter in the fir forests of central Mexico. For thousands of years, many Mexicans believe these butterflies to be the spirits of the dead. Their arrival in winter coincides with Mexico's most spectacular festival, the Day of the Dead.

Mexico's prairies are the birthplace of an iconic way of life. In the 16th century, the Spanish brought cattle and horses here. The vaquero, or cowboy, was born. To protect the fragile vegetation, pioneering ranchers keep their herds on the move, benefitting one of Mexico's rarest birds. Today, only five breeding pairs of Aplomado falcons survive in Northern Mexico.

The land beyond the prairies is starved for rain and is the country's driest region. This area of Northern Mexico is dominated by two great deserts: the Sonoran and Chihuahuan, the latter of which is the second largest desert in North America. Summer temperatures reach 113°F, but one plant copes well: the creosote bush.

The creosote bush grasshopper eats nothing else—the only grasshopper in the world that relies on one plant.

To the west, the dry forests covering the Sierra Madre Occidentalis are a refuge for a plant with the hottest reputation. Wild chillies called chiltepin are harvested here. This "mother of all chillies" was first domesticated in Mexico over 6,000 years ago.

On the western edge of the Sonoran desert, El Pinacate is one of the hottest places on earth. Temperatures reach 132°F and it goes years without rain, even though it borders the sea. Just offshore is Isla San Pedro Martir, a desert island that's home to the remarkable side blotched lizard. It only survives here thanks to the fish scraps left in the nests of visiting sea birds. Proof that if you can find a way, you can thrive in Mexico's "Burning North."

From its hot red heart, to its spectacular and pristine coastline, a particular breed of people also journey through this land. This is their story—past and present, tough and tender.

A Tale of Two Sisters: The Diary of Anne Frank

In 1942, a young girl living in Amsterdam was given a diary as a gift from her father, Otto Frank, for her 13th birthday. What started as an insignificant present would become one of the greatest works of literature from the 20th century. Anne Frank's record of the two years she spent in a cramped attic hiding from Nazi capture gave the world deeply personal insight into the overwhelming horrors of the Holocaust.



A Tale of Two Sisters: The Diary of Anne Frank includes extensive interviews with one of the few people alive today who knew Anne. Eva Schloss was a childhood playmate of Anne's while they were both living in Amsterdam. Their stories would closely parallel each other's, only diverging in the fact that Eva survived Auschwitz while Anne did not. After the war, Otto Frank would marry Eva's mother; Anne would have been her step-sister. Eva tells the story of her brief friendship with Anne, their lives in hiding, and Otto's thinking after Auschwitz's liberation.

A Tale of Two Sisters: The Diary of Anne Frank airs on 3-2 Sunday, the 12th at 5:00 p.m. and Thursday, the 16th at 7:00 p.m. On 3-1, it airs Tuesday, the 14th at 8:00 p.m.

Ancient Invisible Cities

In **Ancient Invisible Cities**, a three-part series, Professor Darius Arya explores the hidden secrets of three of the most fascinating cities of the ancient world: Cairo, Athens, and Istanbul. Arya uses the latest 3D imaging techniques to reveal the secrets of Ancient Egyptian, Roman, and Islamic monuments—architectural jewels seen as they've never been seen before.

He explores the Great Pyramid of Giza and the first pyramid ever built. He also explores a hidden Roman fortress and discovers a well deep in the rock below the Arabic citadel of Saladin. An extraordinary journey through the treasures of Istanbul reveals many of its underground secrets.

The World's Most Expensive Food

London is now home to more billionaires than any other city on the planet. And like all of us, they need feeding. But while we use the supermarket and millionaires use the Michelin guide, billionaires use a private network of luxury food suppliers.

The World's Most Expensive Food is a two-part series that follows the exclusive suppliers who cater to Britain's super-rich clients in a world untouched by austerity.

Daniel Hulme is Maitre D of On Air Dining, a company supplying top-end food to private jets. His point of contact are the flight attendants, who must deal with every demand of their uber-rich clients, including a sudden urge for a Cadbury's creme egg in a remote Russian airfield or knowing the name of the cow that supplied their pot of yogurt!

The "world's most expensive coffee" is supplied by Richard Hardwick, whose coffee is sourced from Indonesian plantations. Luwaks, small carnivorous cats, forage for and eat the best coffee beans. After passing through the Luwak's digestive system, the coffee beans are gathered to produce exclusive £300 (about \$400) per cup coffee.

Vintage cognac specialist Salvatore Calabrese sources some of the most expensive spirits on the planet. He serves a Russian property magnate a single shot of an 1811 Napoleon Grande Reserve for £5,000 (about \$6,600).

Since "normal" caviar is no longer posh enough for the uber-rich, Kenneth Benning attempts to launch a new product—an elixir of youth—on his caviar farm. He infuses his sturgeon caviar with an extract from the spawn of an African Clawed Frog, which is said to have miraculous medicinal properties. But things don't go smoothly for Ken or his frogs.

Ascent of Woman: A 10,000 Year Story
