Roméo et Juliette

Hailed by The New York Times for singing “with white-hot sensuality and impassioned lyricism,” Diana Damrau and Vittorio Grigolo star as the tragic lovers in Shakespeare’s classic story. Gounod’s “Roméo et Juliette” airs on **Great Performances at the Met**.

The Met’s new production by director Bartlett Sher also features Virginie Verrez as Stéphano, Elliot Madore as Mercutio, and Mikhail Petrenko as Frère Laurent. Gianandrea Nosedà conducts the sumptuous score.

The opera premiered in 1867 at the Théâtre Lyrique in Paris. Perhaps the most enduringly successful of the many operatic settings of the world’s consummate love story, *Roméo et Juliette* is a prime example of French Romanticism, a tradition that values subtlety, sensuality, and graceful vocal delivery over showy effects. In the opera there is a slight shift of focus away from the word games of the original play and a greater focus on the two lovers, who are given four irresistible duets, including a brief final reunion in the tomb scene that does not appear in the play.

Gounod’s “Roméo et Juliette” on **Great Performances at the Met** airs on 3-2 Friday, the 14th at 9:00 p.m. On 3-1 it airs Friday, the 14th at 12:00 midnight and Saturday, the 15th at 8:00 p.m.

Last Days of Jesus

For almost two millennia, the events of the Passion of Christ as chronicled in the Gospels, have been honored and celebrated by Christians from around the world. The story of Jesus has engrained itself into global consciousness as that of a mystical healer, teacher and Rabbi, who wandered pastoral lands and preached to his disciples in preparation for a divine kingdom to come, ultimately sacrificing his life for the sake of all.



Yet in recent years, a growing number of religious experts and historians have begun to question the canonical version of events. **Last Days of Jesus** uncovers a different story about the man behind the myth—a revolutionary at the center of the political and religious turmoil of his time. Young Men

Compelling Dance Film

The internationally acclaimed, all-male dance company BalletBoyz is featured in the compelling narrative dance film “Young Men,” airing on **Great Performances**. The film follows a group of young soldiers as they experience the indiscriminate brutality of warfare.

Airing in commemoration of the centennial of World War I, the feature-length film was shot on location in Northern France. Based on a highly successful stage production that premiered at London’s Sadler’s Wells Theatre in January 2015 (and returned in October by popular demand), it is choreographed by Iván Pérez with a commissioned score by critically acclaimed recording artist, singer-songwriter Keaton Henson.

The narrative follows a young soldier and his squadron’s experience of basic training, combat, and ultimately, the destruction of modern warfare. The film is shot without words, instead using the locations and carefully choreographed dance to depict the devastation of a continent. The characters themselves remain ambiguous, representative of the experiences of young men of every nation as they struggle to maintain their humanity in an unending cycle of combat and death.

These young men succumb to the terror of their situation in a myriad of ways. War takes its mental and bodily toll on these comrades, as they struggle to survive one day’s destruction, only to wake to another’s mortal threats. A potent combination of music and choreography, the film is an immersive emotional journey into the reality facing young men at the extremes of human experience.

“Young Men” on **Great Performances** will air on 3-2 Friday, the 7th at 9:00 p.m. and on 3-1, Friday the 7th at 12:00 midnight and Saturday, the 8th at 8:00 p.m.



For this project, the dancers did a lot of research: from books and photographs as well as films from the Imperial War Museum Collection. They wanted to portray these scenes of men at war in moments that will resonate across a landscape of all wars in order to look at the experience of soldiers in general.

Call the Midwife

The critically acclaimed British drama “Call the Midwife” returns to PBS for a sixth season on **Masterpiece**. Season 6 begins in 1962 and it is evident how times are changing, from increased liberation for women to the shadow of infamous gangsters to the introduction of new government policies.

In Poplar, when the rather austere Sister Ursula is appointed the new head of Nonnatus House, Sister Julianne finds herself demoted and working alongside the midwives as an ordinary member of the staff. She is not the only one to face challenges closer to home. As they strive to help mothers and families cope with the demands of childbearing, disability, disease and social prejudice, the beloved medics must make choices — and fight battles — of their own.

In Season 6, the midwives laugh together, cry together and support each other as never before, while continuing to address complex medical and personal dilemmas on their midwifery and district nursing rounds.

“Call the Midwife” airs on 3-2 Sundays, beginning the 2nd at 7:00 p.m. It airs on 3-1 Sundays at 6:00 p.m. and repeats Mondays at 6:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.



Home Fires: The Final Season

The Final Season of “Home Fires” follows the village when conflict takes hold. As the separation from their husbands, fathers, sons and brothers becomes more painful, the women rely on one another and the friendships forged through village life. It will take calm, fortitude, and creativity to bring the diverse women of the village together, and to help the community survive what is to come. It’s June 1940, and Britain faces the threat of imminent invasion.

Samantha Bond (*Downton Abbey*) and Francesca Annis (*Reckless*) head an extraordinary cast in a moving drama about women in an English village facing World War II. Calm, fortitude, and creativity are the watchwords on “Home Fires: The Final Season,” airing in six inspiring episodes on **Masterpiece**.

Bond plays forward-thinking Frances Barden, a born leader with a stubborn streak, while Annis is her antagonist, Joyce Cameron, obsessed with class and tradition. The two are bitter rivals for control of the local Women’s Institute, a nationwide service organization. With war looming, their chapter faces its moment of truth. Will the largely social group shut up shop for the duration, or will it reinvent itself to help the nation in its hour of need?

“Home Fires: The Final” season can be seen Sundays on 3-2 at 8:00 p.m. and Fridays, at 10:00 p.m. (or later). It will air on 3-1 Sundays, at 7:00 p.m. and Mondays, at 7:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

The Great War

Drawing on the latest scholarship, including unpublished diaries, memoirs and letters, “The Great War” on **American Experience** tells the rich and complex story of World War I through the voices of nurses, journalists, aviators and the American troops who came to be known as “doughboys.” The series explores the experiences of African-American and Latino soldiers, suffragists, Native-American “code talkers” and others whose participation in the war to “make the world safe for democracy” has been largely forgotten.

“The Great War” also explores how a brilliant PR man bolstered support for the war in a country hesitant to put lives on the line for a foreign conflict; how President Woodrow Wilson steered the nation through almost three years of neutrality, only to reluctantly lead America into the bloodiest conflict the world had ever seen, thereby transforming the United States into a dominant player on the international stage.

It is also a story of little known heroism and sacrifice (including the deadliest battle in American history) that would leave more than 53,000 men dead on the battlefield and more than 60,000 dead from disease. American fatalities would come at a critical time in the war, but they would be dwarfed by a cataclysm of violence that would ultimately claim 15 million lives.

“The Great War” will be broadcast on 3-2 in two-hour blocks on Monday through Wednesday evenings, the 10th, 11th, and 12th. INDEPENDENT LENS

On December 14, 2012, a disturbed young man committed a horrific mass shooting in Newtown, Connecticut, that took the lives of 20 elementary school children and six educators. *Newtown*, a searing new documentary, filmed over the course of nearly three years that uses deeply personal, never before-heard testimonies to relate the after math of the deadliest mass shooting of school children in American history. Through raw and heartbreaking interviews with parents, siblings, teachers, doctors and first responders, *Newtown* documents a traumatized community still reeling from the senseless tragedy, fractured by grief but driven toward a sense of purpose.

There are no words of compassion or reassurance that can bring back those who lost their lives during the shooting at Sandy Hook Elementary School. Instead, Snyder delves into the lives and homes of those who remain, all of whom have been indelibly changed by the events. They speak candidly about their grief, anger and disbelief over what occurred and their disappointment that nothing has truly changed with regard to the country's legal response to gun violence.

Newtown bears witness to their profound grief and allows it to reverberate within our collective conscience, exploring what happens to a community after it becomes the epicenter of a national discussion and what it must cope with after the cameras leave.


