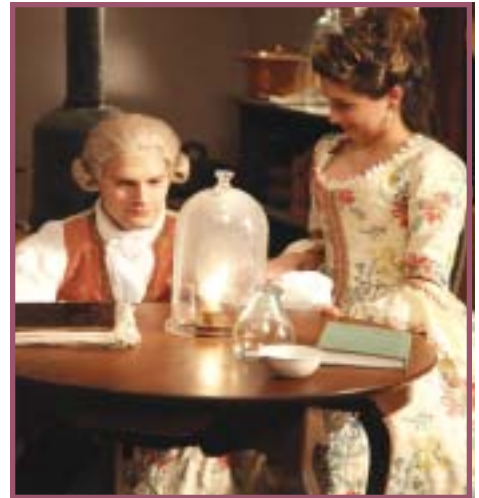
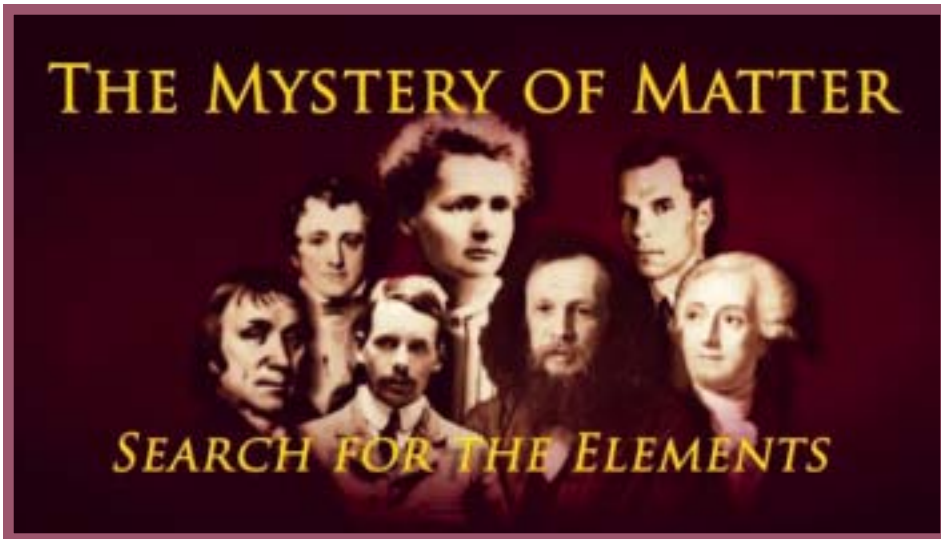

The Mystery of Matter: Search for the Elements is an exciting series about one of the great adventures in the history of science: the long quest to understand what the world is made of—to identify, understand, and organize the basic building blocks of matter.

Three hour-long episodes introduce viewers to some of history's most extraordinary scientists:

- *Joseph Priestley and Antoine Lavoisier—one of science's great odd couples—whose discovery of oxygen, and radical interpretation of it, triggers a worldwide search for elements and leads to the modern science of chemistry;

- *Chemist Humphry Davy, who is soon caught up in the hunt and makes electricity a powerful new tool in the search for elements;

- *Dmitri Mendeleev, who invents the Periodic Table, bringing order to the growing gaggle of elements;

- *Marie Curie, who shatters this order when she discovers radioactivity, revealing that elements can change identities—and atoms contain undiscovered parts;

- *Harry Moseley, who, caught up in the race to discover the atom's internal parts, uses newly discovered X-rays to put the Periodic Table in a whole new light; and

- *Glenn Seaborg, whose discovery of plutonium opens up a whole new realm of elements, changing the world forever.

The Mystery of Matter shows us not only *what* these scientific explorers discovered but also *how*, using Broadway-caliber actors to reveal the creative process through the scientists' own words, and conveying their landmark discoveries through re-enactments shot with working replicas of their original lab equipment.

The Mystery of Matter: Search for the Elements will be broadcast Wednesday, the 19th beginning at 7:00 p.m. and Sunday, the 23rd beginning at 10:00 p.m. (all three episodes air back-to-back on both dates). They repeat (one episode per week) Sundays at 10:00 a.m. beginning the 23rd. On HD3-1, all three episodes can be seen Thursday, the 20th beginning at 6:00 a.m. and then again at 12:00 noon, and Saturday, the 22nd, beginning at 7:00 p.m.

National Gallery

Journey to the heart of a London institution, a museum housing masterpieces of Western art from the Middle Ages to the 19th century.

This three-hour special turns its lens on England's **National Gallery**—capturing in fascinating detail the paintings, patrons, artists, and administrators who keep the institution going.

The London museum, one of the world's foremost art institutions, is itself portrayed as a brilliant work of art. Viewers can listen as guides decode the great canvases of Da Vinci, Rembrandt, and Turner. Viewers visit the museum's restorers as they use magnifying glasses, tiny eye-droppers, scalpels, and Q-tips to repair an infinitesimal chip. Then viewers attend administrative meetings in which senior executives do (polite) battle with younger ones who want the museum to become less stodgy and more welcoming to a larger cross-section of the public.

But most of all, viewers experience the joy of spending time with the aforementioned masters as well as Vermeer and Caravaggio, Titian and Velasquez, Pissarro and Rubens, and listen as connoisseurs explain the aesthetic, historical, religious, and psychological underpinnings of these masterpieces.

National Gallery will be broadcast Friday, the 21st at 9:00 p.m. and Sunday, the 23rd at 12:00 noon.





JFK & LBJ: A Time for Greatness

President Lyndon B. Johnson engineered the passing of two of the most important laws Congress ever approved: the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Voting Rights Act of 1965. The Civil Rights Act is considered one of the crowning legislative achievements of the civil rights movement, but the Voting Rights Act that followed the next year changed the country forever.

As we celebrate the 50th anniversary of President Johnson's signing of the Voting Rights Act on August 6th, 1965, **JFK & LBJ: A Time for Greatness** examines how Johnson meticulously worked behind the scenes to outwit the Southern segregationists who were determined to maintain the racial divide. He cajoled, flattered, wheeled and dealt, using all the tricks he had learned as a long-serving Senator, to ultimately transform America.

JFK & LBJ: A Time for Greatness will be broadcast Tuesday, the 4th at 8:00 p.m. On HD3-1, it airs Tuesday, the 4th at 7:00 p.m. and Wednesday, the 5th at 7:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.

MYSTERIOUS DISEASES

Due to intense medical research, many diseases can often be addressed very handily. However, **Mysterious Diseases** or rare diseases can be very different. From the producers of **Healthy Body Healthy Mind**, this hour-long program looks at several rare diseases.

Pompe Disease is a rare, neuromuscular disease, that can present itself in infancy, adulthood, or anywhere in between. Infants often experience weakness, enlargement of the tongue, and thickening of the heart muscles, resulting in dangerous, sometime deadly consequences.

Acute Intermittent Porphyria (AIP) is a rare metabolic disease, causing a buildup of natural chemicals that keep red blood cells from working properly—including the

The Vienna Philharmonic Summer Night Concert 2015

With conductor Zubin Mehta, the renowned Vienna Philharmonic returns in **Great Performances** "The Vienna Philharmonic Summer Night Concert 2015." From the magnificent gardens of Austria's Imperial Schönbrunn Palace, this year's concert features a distinctly Scandinavian flavor.

The concert soloist is Austrian piano virtuoso Rudolf Buckbinder, who plays Norwegian composer Edvard Grieg's *Piano Concerto in A minor*. First performed in Copenhagen in 1868, that famous work is followed by the *Soirée de Vienne* by the pianist and composer Alfred Grünfeld, who was born in Vienna in 1852.

The penultimate piece is the *Copenhagen Steam Railway Galop* by Danish composer Hans Christian Lumbye who was so in awe of Johann Strauss Sr. that he began to compose in his style, earning him the title "The Strauss of the North."

Great Performances "The Vienna Philharmonic Summer Night Concert 2015" airs Friday, the 28th at 9:00 p.m. and Sunday, the 30th at 10:00 p.m. On HD3-1, it airs Saturday, the 29th at 7:00 p.m.





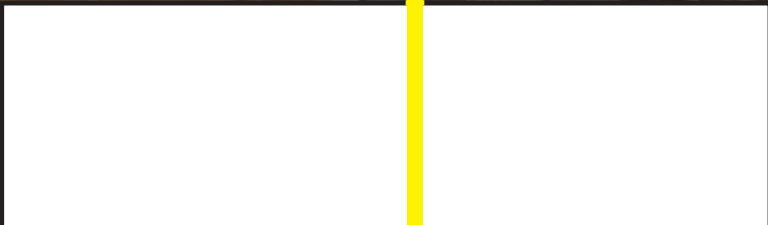
