The Hollow Crown: The Wars of the Roses

“The Hollow Crown: The Wars of the Roses” is a lavish three-part follow-up to the four-part “The Hollow Crown” which aired on **Great Performances**. The first series of “The Hollow Crown” covered the so-called Henriad, comprising Richard II, Henry IV, Parts I and II, and Henry V. Now, “The Wars of the Roses” continues the epic saga with three more lavish film adaptations of Shakespeare’s history plays: Henry VI, Parts I and II, and Richard III. Together, they span rebellion in France, the rise and fall of Joan of Arc, the terror of England’s Civil War, and the deceitful dynastic murders culminating in the infamous reign of Richard III.

The series features some of the UK’s finest acting talent, including Benedict Cumberbatch as Richard III, Tom Sturridge as Henry VI, Hugh Bonneville as Duke of Gloucester, and Judi Dench as Cecily, Duchess of York.

As “Henry VI, Part 1” opens, the King is dead and England is in crisis. War rages with the French and divisions within the English court threaten the crown. Young Henry VI causes outrage by marrying Margaret of Anjou, forcing an unwanted truce.

In “Henry VI, Part 2,” bitter rivalries erupt into the Wars of the Roses. The feeble King Henry is overshadowed by Queen Margaret and her faction of Lancastrian Lords, his reign further undermined by disaffected nobles supporting the House of York. Battle and bloodshed ensue and the Yorkists triumph. Edward IV takes the throne, but his youngest brother Richard has his eyes firmly on the crown.

In “Richard III,” the most notorious of Shakespeare’s kings manipulates and betrays his way through the court on a bloodthirsty and ruthless path to the throne. But after Richard’s defeat at the battle of Bosworth Field, the Houses of Lancaster and York—the red rose and the white—are united, bringing to an end the Wars of the Roses.

Great Performances “The Hollow Crown: The Wars of the Roses” airs on 3-2 on three consecutive Sundays at 8:00 p.m. beginning the 11th. On 3-1, it airs the same evenings at 9:00 p.m.

The moment when Vincent van Gogh looked into a mirror, held up a blade, and cut into his own ear defines his turbulent life and art. But what did he really do on the night of December 23rd, 1888, in the town of Arles? What was his state of mind? No one has been clear on the details ... until now.

Bernadette Murphy, an Irish-born historian and researcher living in Provence, has spent five years piecing together a meticulous picture of his life in Arles, person by person, house by house. She has uncovered definitive evidence, never before published, and pieced together a detailed timeline of the events leading up to the night of the event, explaining the driving force behind the story that dominates art history.

“Van Gogh’s Ear” on **Secrets of the Dead** will be broadcast Wednesday, the 14th at 9:00 p.m. and Monday, the 19th at 10:00 p.m. On 3-1, it can be seen Monday, the 19th at 8:00 p.m.

Catholicism: The Pivotal Players

Catholicism: The Pivotal Players, created and hosted by Bishop Robert Barron, is a six-part series that illuminates a handful of saints, artists, mystics, and scholars who not only shaped the life of the Church, but changed the course of civilization. Besides the passionate intensity of their Catholic faith, they all shared something else in common: Each lived at a time of crisis for the Church, and each helped the Church to address that crisis in a creative way. The two episodes available for broadcast at this time are “Michelangelo” and “St. Francis of Assisi.”

In “Michelangelo,” Bishop Barron studies some of the greatest works of art in the world by one of the greatest geniuses in human history, Michelangelo, whose talents included sculpture, printing, architecture, poetry, and other fields. From the magnificent David in Florence to the paintings in the Sistine Chapel to the Pietà in Rome, the legacy of Michelangelo reveals the creative potential of the hu-

man spirit and shows that beauty is a route of access to the transcendent.

“St. Francis of Assisi” journeys from the lovely streets and basilicas of Assisi and Gubbio to the gorgeous, remote monasteries of La Verna and Eremito delle Carceri.

Bishop Barron explores the extraordinary life of St. Francis of Assisi, the little friar from Umbria who became one of the most important and influential figures of the Middle Ages.

Eero Saarinen: The Architect Who Saw the Future

American Masters “Eero Saarinen: The Architect Who Saw the Future” explores the life and visionary work of Finnish-American modernist architectural giant Eero Saarinen (1910-1961). Best known for designing St. Louis’ iconic Gateway Arch, Saarinen also designed New York’s



TWA Flight Center at John F. Kennedy International Airport, Yale University’s Ingalls Rink, Virginia’s Dulles Airport, and modernist pedestal furniture like the Tulip chair. His sudden death at age 51 cut short one of the most influential careers in American architecture.

The son of prominent Finnish architect Eliel Saarinen and textile designer Loja Saarinen, Eero was surrounded by design his whole life, as was his son Eric, whose mother Lily Saarinen was a sculptor, artist, and educator. Immigrating at the age of 13 to Michigan, Eero attended Cranbrook Academy of Art, designed by his father who taught there and became the school’s first president, as well as the chief architect of the Cranbrook campus, with Eero designing details like gargoyles and chairs. Eric also grew up at Cranbrook surrounded by his parents, grandparents, and friends, including his godparents, designers Charles and Ray Eames.

American Masters “Eero Saarinen: The Architect Who Saw the Future” airs on 3-2 Tuesday, the 27th at 7:00 p.m. On 3-1, it can be seen Tuesday, the 27th at 8:00 p.m. and Wednesday, the 28th at 7:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

Shakespeare Live!

From the Royal Shakespeare Company

To commemorate the 400th anniversary of William Shakespeare’s death on April 23rd, 2016, The Royal Shakespeare Company (RSC) hosted a glittering jubilee party with an all-star cast.

“Shakespeare Live!” on **Great Performances** celebrates the international legacy of Shakespeare in all the performing arts, including opera, ballet, hip hop, blues, jazz, and musical theater, from The Bard’s hometown of Stratford-upon-Avon.
