This hour-long special showcases the legendary gospel songs, sung by the pioneers of the music, that provided spiritual nourishment for thousands during the 60s, 70s, and early 80s. Performances include “Oh, Mary Don’t You Weep” by the Caravans; “Oh, What A Meeting It Will Be” by the Soul Stirrers; “Amazing Grace” by Albertina Walker; “Pray On My Child” by the Staple Singers; and others.

This beautiful watercolor reflects the winter beauty of the New Mexico landscape and its unique southwestern adobe structures, many of which are the quaint churches that dot the landscape throughout the state.

In **Watercolor with Birdsong**, Jon demonstrates his watercolor techniques while painting “Going to be Cold this Sunday,” from the beginning to completion. Full-sized prints of the painting are being offered as “thank you gifts” during our winter membership drive.

Birdsong spent more than three decades teaching art in the public schools while pursuing his painting career and teaching watercolor workshops throughout the country. One of his paintings—an original “Birdsong”—hung in the White House during President Gerald Ford’s administration.

Birdsong considers his painting style to be loose realism with a smattering of impressionism. Most of his work is of the Texas and New Mexico landscapes. His work can be seen at Weem’s Gallery in Albuquerque, NM, or at his studio in Portales, NM.

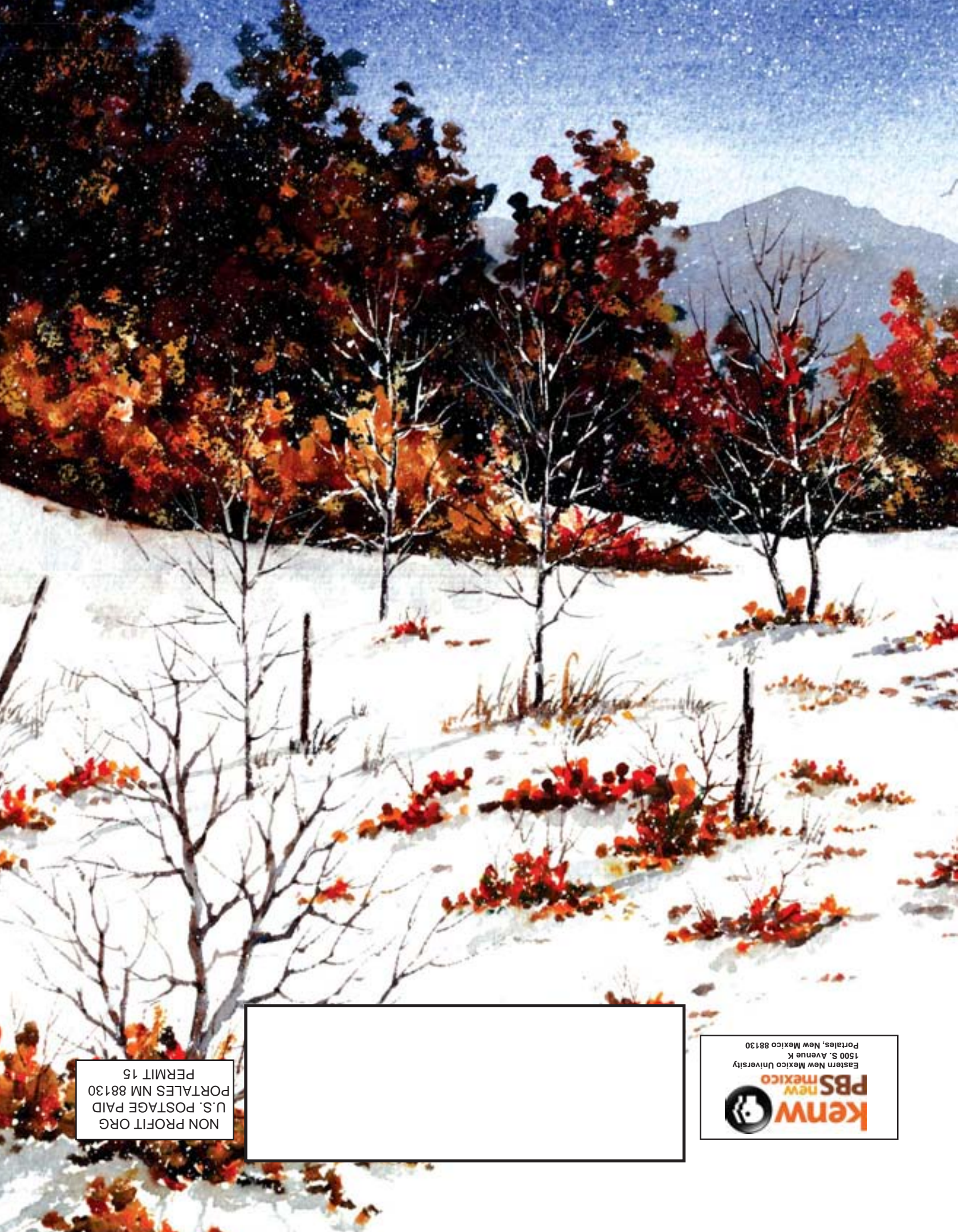
