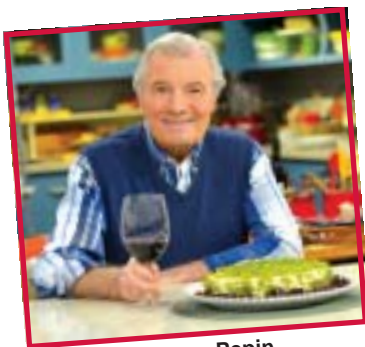

Rebalancing these three brain chemicals enables the rest of our brain's chemistry to reach optimal levels. Small and achievable changes in one's everyday life can lead to thinking more clearly and feeling more calm and focused.

## Super Genes with Dr. Rudy Tanzi

Dr. Rudy Tanzi presents a bold new understanding of our genes in his latest special, **Super Genes**. Dr. Tanzi, Professor of Neurology and Director of Genetics and Aging Research at Massachusetts General Hospital, is in the forefront of finding the genes and a cure for Alzheimer's disease (AD). He co-discovered all three genes that cause early-onset familial Alzheimer's disease, including the first AD gene. He is developing new therapies for treating and preventing AD based on his genetic discoveries.

Genetics is undergoing a revolution that for the first time opens the way for people to influence their own gene activity. 95% of disease related gene mutations can be influenced by diet, behavior, and other environmental conditions. Studies have shown that a program of positive lifestyle changes alter 4,000-5,000 different gene activities.

### Pete Townshend's Classic Quadrophenia

As a leading icon of the British music revolution of the 1960s, Pete Townshend made his name by creating the power chord, smashing guitars onstage, and penning anthems of teenage rebellion. Now, at 70 years old, Townshend has created a "classical" version of one of The Who's landmark albums "Quadrophenia"—for a symphony orchestra, opera singer, and choir.

Filmed live at the Royal Albert Hall in London, **Pete Townshend's Classic Quadrophenia** features Townshend himself and popular British tenor Alfie Boe, along with Billy Idol and Phil Daniels.

The new incarnation of this classic rock opera is the latest chapter in Townshend's lifelong mission to break the three-minute mold of the traditional pop song and take rock music to a higher artistic level.

### Alice's Restaurant 50th Anniversary Concert

It was 50 years ago when Arlo Guthrie, the 18-year-old son of Woody Guthrie, and his friend were spending Thanksgiving with Alice and Ray Brock in the Berkshires. When Alice asked the boys to take a load of trash to the town dump, they found that it was closed. So, they threw the trash down a nearby hillside. This action led to Arlo's arrest for littering, a court appearance, and rejection from military service,—all depicted in his hilarious and iconic song, "Alice's Restaurant." The song (an 18 minute musical monologue) went platinum, spawned a motion picture, and has been played on hundreds of radio stations at Thanksgiving.

In **Alice's Restaurant 50th Anniversary Concert**, Arlo deftly performs the song for the first time in over a decade, along with other career hits.

## In Defense of Food

**In Defense of Food** with *New York Times* best-selling author Michael Pollan reveals how common sense and old-fashioned wisdom can help us rediscover the pleasures of eating and at the same time reduce our risks of falling victim to diet-related diseases.

Almost every day there's a new headline about food. Eat more fiber. Drink less milk. Eggs are bad. Eggs are good. No wonder people are confused. **In Defense of Food** begins with an exploration of the kind of food most Americans eat today—known as the Western diet. It includes lots of meat, white flour, sugar, and vegetable oils. It's cheap, convenient, and has been processed to taste really good.

But the effects of the Western diet on health include alarming increases in obesity and Type 2 diabetes. So if the Western diet makes us sick, what kind of diet will make us healthy? Pollan's search for the answer leads him to explore the kinds of food that come from nature.

Pollan's journey of discovery takes him from the plains of Tanzania, where one of the world's last remaining tribes of hunter-gatherers still eats the way our ancestors did, to Loma Linda, California, where vegetarian Seventh Day Adventists enjoy remarkable longevity, and eventually to Paris, where the French diet, rooted in culture and tradition, proves surprisingly healthy.

Along the way, he shows how a combination of faulty nutrition science and deceptive marketing practices have encouraged us to replace real food with scientifically engineered "food-like substances." The two-hour program also looks at why nutritional guidelines that advised reducing fat in our diet had the unintended consequence of increasing obesity.

And Pollan explains that it's "very rare in our lives where the answer to a complicated question is so simple, but when it comes to eating, it is." *Eat Food. Not Too Much. Mostly Plants.*

In "A Nation of Hypocrites," gangsters make huge profits and wreak havoc in cities across the country. By the late 1920s, many Americans believe that Prohibition—the "Noble Experiment"—has failed. After the election of FDR in 1932, Prohibition is repealed.
