Two highly regarded British actors—Ian McKellen and Dereck Jacobi—bring a new dose of fun and humor in **Vicious**, a six-part series of half-hour episodes.

Following a rich tradition of British sitcoms known for their broad, boisterous humor, **Vicious** tells the story of partners Freddie (McKellen) and Stuart (Jacobi), who have lived together in a small central London flat for nearly 50 years.

Constantly picking each other apart and holding on to petty slights for decades, Freddie and Stuart are always at each other’s throats, cracking snide remarks aimed at the other’s age, appearance, and flaws. However, underneath their vicious, co-dependent fighting, they have a deep affection for one another.

Vicious will be broadcast Sundays at 9:30 p.m. beginning June 29th on both 3-2 and HD3-1.

Barbara (Felicity Kendal), Tom’s wife, agrees to his outlandish plan and without a second thought, he quits his job.

celebrate their first harvest and then decide to take their battle for self-sufficiency even further—from spinning wool and rearing chickens to converting animal dung into electricity.

Give It All Away: Newman's Own Recipe for Success

The story of Paul Newman's legacy as a philanthropist is told in **Give It All Away: Newman's Own Recipe for Success**. The half-hour program chronicles the path of the Newman's Own Foundation food company which has, to date, distributed more than \$370 million to various efforts around the world.



In 1980, Paul Newman and A.E. Hotchner filled empty wine bottles with his homemade salad dressing to give away as holiday gifts. After friends and

neighbors came clamoring for refills, Paul and "Hotch" were convinced that the special recipe was good enough to be bottled and sold.

Newman's Own Salad Dressing was launched in 1982. The first year of profits exceeded \$300,000 and Paul declared, "Let's give it all away to those who need it." It was a unique concept at the time, giving away all after-tax profits.

Give It All Away airs Saturday, June 7th at 10:30 p.m., Sunday, June 15th at 10:30 p.m., and Tuesday, June 17th at 7:30 p.m. On HD3-1, it airs Monday, June 16th at 8:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. and Saturday, June 28th at 9:30 p.m.

Tanaquil Le Clercq: Afternoon of a Faun

Known to all as "Tanny," ballerina Tanaquil Le Clercq was the wife of George Balanchine, one of the greatest geniuses in the history of dance; she also sparked the creative imagination of Jerome Robbins. In 1954, at the height of her fame, she was struck down by polio.

"Tanaquil Le Clercq: Afternoon of a Faun" on **American Masters** finds a tone to match Tanny's exquisite dancing and long, lovely physique. It is the compelling story of a dancer who can no longer dance and a muse who can no longer inspire, as well as a vivid portrayal of a world and a time gone by.

Driven to *di*STRACTION "I only looked down for a second."

Driven to Distraction, produced in New Mexico, highlights the most recent brain research involving cell phone use, DWI, and other causes of crashes. The program reports on why distracted driving crashes are rising at an alarming rate, especially for young people.

The program is designed to help viewers understand the dangers associated with distracted driving and provide them with specific tools and suggestions to lessen the chance of a crash. With regard to teenagers, in particular, the program emphasizes good choices when driving and also the serious consequences of bad choices. Research shows:

- Talking on the cell phone while driving (hand held or hands free) is the same impairment as having a .08 BAC (blood alcohol content).
- Drivers using cell phones are 5 times more likely to crash than non-distracted drivers.
- 78% of teens now have cell phones and 47% are smart phones.
- One in four teens respond to a text message once or more every time they drive.
- More than 3,800 drivers aged 15-20 are killed and over 325,000 are injured every year in crashes.
- One teenage passenger with a teen driver doubles the risk of a fatal crash; the risk is five times higher when two or more teens ride along.

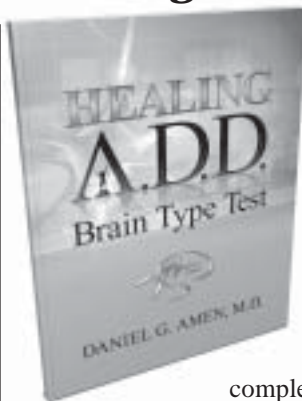

Tragedy & Courage on the Bering Sea

In **Tragedy & Courage on the Bering Sea**, Captain Dave Shoemaker gives a gripping account of the fire that consumed his 190-foot fishing vessel, *Galaxy*, in 2002.

Shoemaker was alone in the wheelhouse shortly after 1600 hours when one of his foremen burst into the wheelhouse and shouted that there was smoke in the fish factory. Within four minutes, the vessel would be rocked by the first of many explosions. Crippled, without power or steerage in the fifteen to twenty foot seas and 30-knot winds, forced out of the wheelhouse by the intense fire that roared out of control below decks, without radio communications, with men in the water, with the port life raft consumed in flames, and survival suits melting on the blistering deck plates, Shoemaker struggled to save his crew mates and himself.

For saving twenty three of the twenty six men and women aboard the *Galaxy* that day, Shoemaker would be awarded the U.S. Coast Guard's Gold Lifesaving Medal, the agency's highest civilian commendation for heroism.

Anders Zorn in the Gilded Age

One of the most famous living artists at the turn of the 20th century, Swedish born Anders Zorn (1860–1920) dazzled the art world with his bravura paintings, watercolors, and etchings. His early travels took him to Spain and Algeria where the intense color and light inspired the virtuoso watercolorist to perfect his craft. Zorn loved the female form and was famous for his nude paintings as well as his vivid depictions of water.

Zorn made numerous trips to the United States and among his most significant American portraits were those of presidents Grover Cleveland and William Howard Taft. While in America, he rivaled John Singer Sargent as the most sought-after portraitist of glittering high society.
