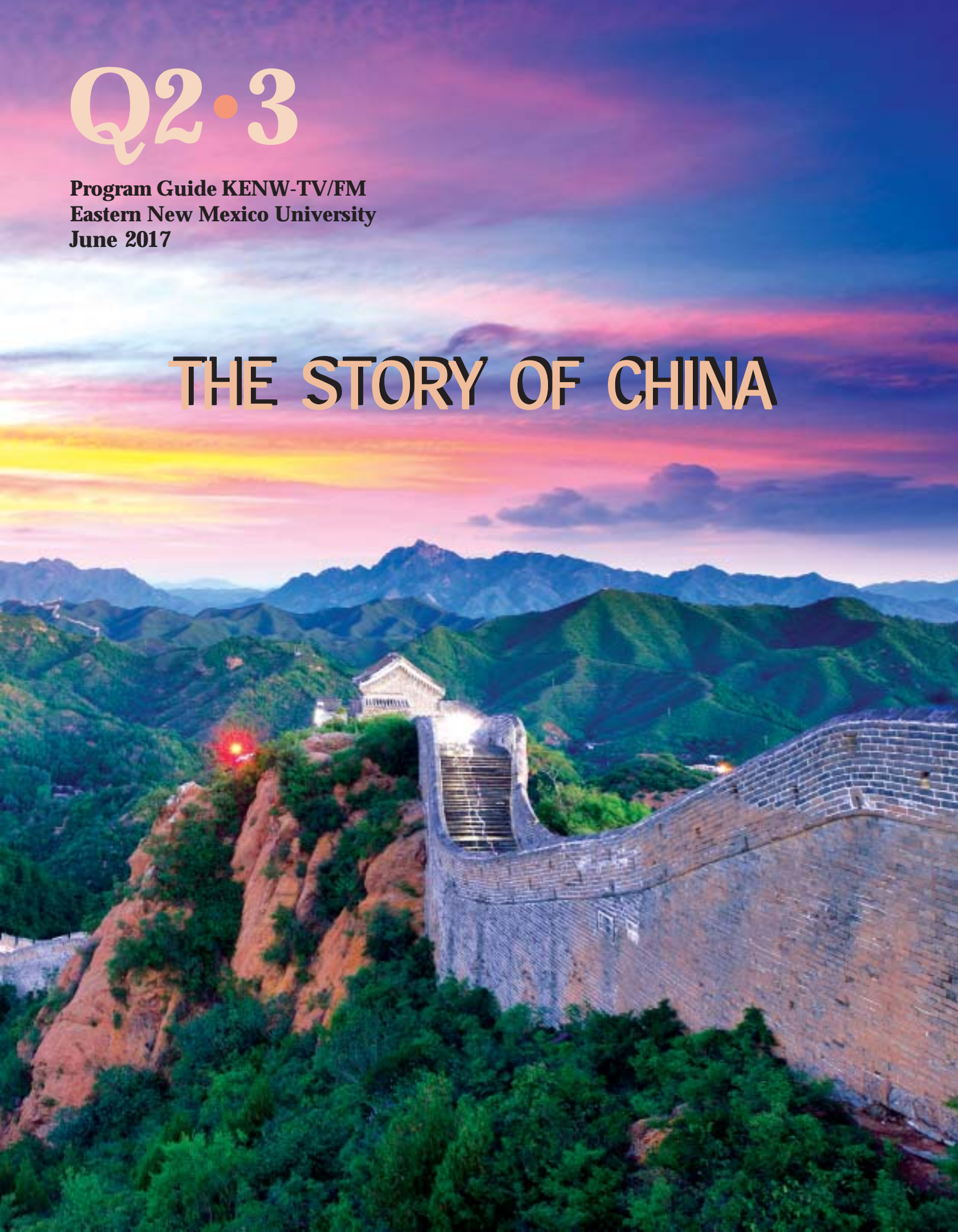

My Mother and Other Strangers

Moybeg in 1943, bringing hundreds of gum-chewing, swing-band-listening American airmen to a remote Ulster farming community, with its winsome women and stolid working men.

The action is framed from the point of view of a young boy, Francis Coyne (played by Michael Nevin). Francis's childhood is populated by strangers. On the one hand, there are the friendly Americans in their Jeeps and airplanes, who treat him like a little brother. Then there is his mother, Rose (Morahan), an upright Englishwoman who married Michael Coyne (Owen McDonnell) and moved to his hometown, Moybeg, where she is raising their three children. Despite being a pillar of the community, Rose has never fit in. She speaks more properly than the locals, loves English literature, and has a lively interest in the wider world.

Into this isolated domain comes Captain Ronald Dreyfus (Aaron Staton), U.S. Army Air Forces, who encounters Rose during a walk on the heath. When they meet again, he quotes her a line from Tennyson's "The Lady of Shalott"—one of her favorite poems.

In his capacity as base liaison officer, Captain Dreyfus has occasion to see Rose frequently. Both would-be lovers fight against the stronger feelings that are overwhelming them. Wary of betraying her husband, Rose feels seized by some otherworldly force, a sentiment she can only recognize from a piece of literature—Emily Brontë's *Wuthering Heights*—which she quotes from memory: "Be with me always—take any form—drive me mad! only do not leave me in this abyss, where I cannot find you!"

Grantchester 3

"Grantchester" on **Masterpiece** returns after last season's cliffhanger ending for Reverend Sidney Chambers (James Norton) and the woman he loves, Amanda (Morven Christie). What sort of future can there be for a vicar and married woman carrying her husband's child? Robson Green also returns as Sidney's best friend, Inspector Geordie Keating, in seven new episodes that follow the improbable crime-fighting duo.

"Grantchester 3" begins the week before Christmas, 1954. Vicar Sidney Chambers is engrossed with holiday duties, but distracted by an impossible situation—how can a vicar and a woman carrying her estranged husband's baby ever make it work? If that isn't enough to keep him busy, there's a new case to solve. When a would-be groom is found dead with the wedding rings lodged in his mouth, Geordie is horrified: these are the hallmarks of a years-old unsolved murder.

Prime Suspect: Tennison

"Prime Suspect: Tennison," the highly anticipated prequel to the hit series "Prime Suspect," is a six-part drama that portrays the early career of one of television's most iconic detectives, Jane Tennison—the role that established Dame Helen Mirren as a household name in the groundbreaking **Masterpiece** series "Prime Suspect."

"Prime Suspect: Tennison" is a visually-stunning, cinematic style drama which re-winds to 1970s London where viewers meet Jane (Stefanie Martini) as an ambitious, single-minded 22-year-old probationary officer, starting out in an environment where chauvinism and rule-bending are the norm. Jane's dedicated, instinctive approach is

evident from the start as she is thrown into a brutal murder inquiry, witnessing firsthand the devastating effect of violent crime, and experiencing tragic ramifications herself.

"Prime Suspect: Tennison" is adapted from the bestselling novel *Tennison* by acclaimed author Lynda La Plante, who created the original "Prime Suspect" series. Admired equally by critics and audiences, "Prime Suspect" won Emmys® for Outstanding Miniseries and Outstanding Actress for Helen Mirren.

"Prime Suspect: Tennison" on **Masterpiece** airs on 3-2 Sundays at 9:00 p.m. beginning the 23rd. On 3-1, it can be seen Sundays at 8:00 p.m. beginning the 23rd.

In **The Story of China**, a three-part six-hour special, Michael Wood explores ancient

myths and archaeological sites to uncover the origins of the Chinese state. He examines the first Chinese writing and tells the dramatic tale of the bloodthirsty First Emperor.

In a tale of fantastic geographical sweep, Michael conjures up China's first great international age, the Tang Dynasty. From picturesque old cities he travels to the bazaars of the Silk Road in Central Asia, and on to India in the footsteps of the Chinese monk who brought Buddhist texts to China.

Michael tells the tale of China's Renaissance, which happened long before the one in Europe. In the alleys of Kaifeng, the world's greatest city before the 19th century, he hears legends and views a huge working replica of an astronomical clock made by 'China's Leonardo da Vinci.'

The Ming Dynasty was the time of the Great Wall and the Forbidden City, when China sent treasure ships on ocean voyages to Africa and the Persian Gulf. In Suzhou, the 'Venice of China,' he explores the silk industry, ceramics and lacquer-making, and visits one of China's most beautiful gardens. Then in Macao, the arrival of Jesuit missionary



Matteo Ricci begins China's fateful modern exchanges with the West.

Michael tells the dramatic tale of China's last empire, the Qing. In the 18th century, China was the biggest economy in the world, and with that prosperity came a fabulously rich culture. From China's favorite novel, to opera and storytelling houses, and all-women's mosques, it's an age full of surprises. But then came the fateful clash with the British in the First Opium War and the beginning of the end of the empire.

Finally, the film tells the tale of the great Taiping Rebellion in which 20 million died, and the fall of the Empire in 1911. Michael visits Hong Kong's Peninsula Hotel, jewel of the Jazz age, and follows Mao on the Long March to Yan'an, the base of the communist revolution. **The Story of China** ends with Mao's death and the boom time of the last thirty years.

Dalya's Other Country/ 4.1 Miles

P.O.V.'s 30th season kicks off with a series of films on the Syrian war and the ongoing global refugee crisis. The first, "Dalya's Other Country," follows a young Syrian girl and her mother from Aleppo, Syria, who have been displaced by the war at home and are adjusting to their new life in Los Angeles. Effervescent teen Dalya goes to Catholic high school and her mother, Rudayna, enrolls in college as they both walk the line between their Muslim values and the new world in which they find themselves.

"4.1 Miles" follows a day in the life of a captain in the Greek coast guard caught in the middle of the biggest refugee crisis since WWII. Despite limited resources, the captain and his crew attempt to save thousands of migrants from drowning in the Aegean Sea.

The recording system used has been reassembled from original parts and it is now the only one left in the world. The system consists of a single microphone, a towering six-foot amplifier rack, and a live record-cutting lathe, powered by a weight-driven pulley system of clockwork gears. The musicians have roughly three minutes to record their song direct to disc before the weight hits the floor.
