Search for the *Last Supper*

Today, no one disputes the genius of Leonardo da Vinci or the impact of his Milanese masterpiece, the *Last Supper*. But few know that only about 20 percent of Leonardo's original fresco remains. Most experts are resigned to the same conclusion: we no longer know what the painting that ushered in the age of the High Renaissance looked like...or do we?

Based on the new book *Young Leonardo* by art historian Jean-Pierre Isbouts and Christopher Health Brown, an art connoisseur, **Search for the *Last Supper*** embarks on a thrilling quest across Europe in search of a missing masterpiece, one that may finally reveal Leonardo's true vision of the most famous sacred art work in the world.

Filmed on location in Italy, France, and Belgium, with lavish period dramatizations, **Search for the *Last Supper*** culminates with an extraordinary revelation—the discovery that a life-sized canvas, in all its brilliant hues and tones, of the *Last Supper* in a remote Belgian monastery was actually painted by Leonardo and his studio, showing us exactly what the original *Last Supper* looked like.

The film reveals how Isbouts and Brown discovered that Leonardo and his workshop had painted a second *Last Supper* on

canvas, just seven years after the original fresco was completed—making this the most exciting da Vinci discovery in years.

The film also overturns many old and cherished assumptions about Leonardo's early career, showing that Leonardo was not a "celebrity court artist" in Milan, but rather an outlier, which forcefully motivated him to create something revolutionary with the *Last Supper*.

Stealing Your Life with Frank Abagnale

Identity theft affects someone every four seconds. Who is a better target for identity thieves than a Chicago millionaire? The answer might surprise you: your 14-year-old son, for one. Who is a better target than your 14-year-old son? Even more surprising—your new born baby with a social security number.

Stealing Your Life with Frank Abagnale is an essential reference, presented by the unsurpassed authority on identity theft.

Abagnale's years as a con man were depicted in the film "Catch Me If You Can." After serving prison sentences in three different countries, he spent decades as an FBI agent specializing in identity theft and has written several best-selling books on the subject.

In **Stealing Your Life**, Abagnale begins with an account of his earlier years, from running away from home at 16-years-old, to traveling millions of miles around the world while impersonating a Pan Am pilot, to his tenure impersonating a medical doctor, to finally landing in a French prison.

In the program, Abagnale examines the growing problem of identity theft, explaining how incredibly easy it is for anyone to assume someone else's identity, the devastating impact of such a crime, and the ways identity thieves work. He shares dozens of steps viewers can take to protect themselves and their family from identity theft, offering a critical proactive solution to one of today's most nefarious and common crimes.

The program reveals how everyday ordinary occurrences may make you vulnerable to identity thieves, such as writing a check; owning a credit card or debit card; posting a front-facing photo of yourself on social media; sharing personal details of your life on facebook, such as your date and place of birth or your vacation plans; and discarding mail with the address label still intact, just to name a few.

Stealing Your Life with Frank Abagnale airs on 3-2 Sunday, the 11th at 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, the 22nd at 7:00 p.m., and Friday, the 30th at 9:00 p.m. On 3-1, it airs Wednesday the 14th at 2:00 p.m. and Friday, the 23rd at 9:00 p.m.

Into the Night: Portraits of Life and Death, a two-hour film, features nine men and women grappling with the universal questions posed by our mortality. How do we endure when we know death is near—with defiance, as Dylan Thomas exhorts us, "To rage, rage against the dying of the light"? Or with gentle acceptance? Clenched fists? With mordant humor? Or, more commonly, with denial? What story gives our lives meaning in the face of death?

Into the Night presents intimate, candid portraits of individuals from all walks of life—an actor, an astrophysicist, preacher, philosopher, artisanal mortician— young and old, for whom death is no longer a far-off abstraction. Each of them has been shocked into mortality and are forever changed.

For some, witnessing the death of others has shaped their life's direction, their world view and their beliefs. Others, facing terminal illnesses for years, confront their imminent end with unexpected epiphanies. These dramatic accounts challenge, unsettle and inspire while bringing lyrical insight to this often taboo topic.

Weaving science, cryonics, near-death stories and green burials, **Into the Night** invites us to rethink our place in the universe.

An American Home: *Frank Lloyd Wright's B. Harley Bradley House*

Architect Frank Lloyd Wright redefined architecture with the B. Harley Bradley House—one of his earliest designs—in Kankakee, Illinois. This commission helped launch Wright's Prairie School period where he experimented with open floor plans, long ribbons of art-glass windows, horizontal elevations, and other design elements that forever changed how homes were designed.

An American Home: Frank Lloyd Wright's B. Harley Bradley House spotlights the story of this architectural treasure and explores its uncanny connection to the rise, fall, and resurgence of its designer and the community in which it resides. All three have faced moments of great hardship, but have emerged from the struggle, thanks to perseverance and determination.

The Rise and Fall of the Brown Buffalo

The Rise and Fall of the Brown Buffalo is a look at the unorthodox life and complex legacy of Oscar Zeta Acosta, the Chicano movement's forgotten activist hero, radical lawyer, and literary celebrity. The story of Acosta's life served as the basis for the character Dr. Gonzo in *Fear and Loathing in Las Vegas*.

Acosta's powerful literary voice, brash courtroom style and notorious revolutionary antics made him a revered figure within the Chicano movement of the 1960s and 70s, and offered one of the most brazen assaults on the status quo and white supremacy seen at the time.

The Groundbreaking Oral History Project Wants to Record Your Story

In its continuing celebration of everyday Americans, **StoryCorps** is coming to Portales, NM, to record interviews with local residents from March 15th to April 13th as part of its cross-country MobileBooth tour. **StoryCorps** has collected more than 65,000 interviews from Americans in all 50 states, the largest single collection of human voices ever recorded.
