The Miniaturist —

Enter the dollhouse of mystery

Golden Age Amsterdam comes alive in all its opulence and repressed sensuality in an adaptation of Jessie Burton's gripping best-selling novel "The Miniaturist" on **Masterpiece**. Gorgeously filmed on location in The Netherlands and the U.K., the three-part drama tells the story of a young bride who receives mysterious packages from a reclusive maker of miniatures—tiny objects that appear to predict the future. Set in 1686, when the Dutch Republic was one of the world's richest and religiously zealous nations, "The Miniaturist" captures the paradox of extreme wealth combined with puritanical abhorrence of the pleasure that riches make possible.

Petronella Oortman (Anya Taylor-Joy), called Nella, is the unwitting victim of this clash of values. A naïve eighteen-year-old from a bankrupt aristocratic family in the provinces, she is wooed by Johannes Brandt (Alex Hassell), a handsome and prosperous merchant looking for a wife. The two wed, but he dispenses with nuptial intimacies to depart immediately on a business trip, arranging for her to join him at his mansion in Amsterdam a few weeks later.

When Nella arrives, Johannes is still away, leaving her in the care of his grim and overbearing sister, Marin (Romola Garai), and the household's two controlling servants. So begins Nella's virtual imprisonment in the residence where she had expected to be in charge.

After Johannes returns, he remains emotionally cool to Nella, giving evasive reasons. Nonetheless, he shows his affection by pre-

senting her with a singular wedding gift: an exquisitely crafted cutaway model of the very house where she is now living, and he instructs her to furnish it as she likes by calling on the services of one of the local makers of miniature objects—a miniaturist. With nothing else to do, Nella embraces this odd amusement.

The miniaturist that Nella selects communicates only by letter, and with the first order includes items that Nella didn't request: a tiny cradle, a replica of Johannes' dog, and a miniature upholstered chair exactly like the one where Nella is sitting as she unwraps the package.

Published to wide acclaim in 2014, *The Miniaturist* is Jessie Burton's debut novel, inspired by her visits to the Rijksmuseum in Amsterdam, where an elaborate 17th-century dollhouse is on display.

Season 3

Hailed by *The Wall Street Journal* as "an island of charm," "The Durrells in Corfu" on **Masterpiece** returns for a third season of eccentric family adventures on a Greek isle in the 1930s. The bohemian Durrells fit right in with the light-hearted Greeks—except when



they disastrously don't. The eight-part series is based on the memoirs of Gerald Durrell, the animal-loving youngest member of the clan.

In Season 3, actress Keeley Hawes reprises her role as the plucky widowed mother, Louisa, who has made the decision to give up searching

for love, choosing instead to focus on her family. However, with Larry struggling to write his third novel, Margo in search of a new vocation, Gerry continuing to grow his menagerie, and Leslie juggling three different girls, Louisa has her work cut out. When her Aunt Hermione arrives, Louisa is hopeful Hermione will be able to help set her children back on the straight and narrow.

"The Durrells in Corfu" Season 3 on **Masterpiece** premieres on 3-2 Sunday, the 30th at 6:00 p.m. All subsequent episodes of the series (2 through 8) will be broadcast Sundays at 7:00 p.m. beginning October 7th. Poldark

Season 4

Aidan Turner is back as the dashing Captain Ross Poldark alongside Eleanor Tomlinson as Demelza in the brand new Season 4 of "Poldark" on **Masterpiece**, an eight-part series.

It's 1796, and to defend Cornwall and those he loves from an empowered George Warleggan, Ross must play the political game. Ross gears up to move to London to become a Member of Parliament, where he faces new perils. Meanwhile, Demelza remains caught between Ross and a lovesick Hugh Armitage.

At the end of Season 3, Demelza had given into temptation with Armitage while Poldark's attentions were focused elsewhere. The Enyses contemplate having a child and Elizabeth seeks the same to secure her marriage. Sam and Drake are blamed for a murder and Ross finds himself powerless to save his brothers-in-law.

Three documentaries explore the lives of iconic artists Andrew Wyeth, Elizabeth Murray, and Jean-Michel Basquiat

“Wyeth” on **American Masters** is the story of one of America’s most popular, but least understood, artists—Andrew Wyeth. Son of the famous illustrator N.C. Wyeth, Andrew had his first exhibition at age 20, and his painting “Christina’s World” was acquired by the Museum of Modern Art in 1948. While Wyeth’s exhibitions routinely broke attendance records, art world critics continually assaulted his work.

Detailing the stunning drawings and powerful portraits Wyeth created, the film explores his inspirations, including neighbor Christina Olsen and his hidden muse, the German model Helga Testorf, who he painted secretly for 15 years.

Through unprecedented access to Wyeth’s family members and their personal collection and hundreds of Wyeth’s studies, drawings, and paintings, **American Masters** presents the most complete portrait of the artist to date.

“Wyeth” on **American Masters** airs on 3-2 Friday, the 7th at 9:00 p.m. and Sunday, the 16th at 10:00 p.m. On 3-1, it airs Tuesday, the 11th at 7:00 p.m.

“Everybody Knows...Elizabeth Murray” is an intimate portrait of the maverick painter and printmaker. Excerpts from her journals voiced by Meryl Streep and verité footage show Murray’s internal struggles and incredible ambition. Art world luminaries describe the thriving New York art scene within which Murray challenged and captivated her viewers.

The film chronicles her remarkable journey from an impoverished childhood in Chicago to the extraordinary art world of lower Manhattan, before she lost her life to cancer in 2007.

“Everybody Knows...Elizabeth Murray” will be broadcast on 3-2 Friday, the 7th at 10:00 p.m. On 3-1, the program can be seen Tuesday, the 11th at 9:00 p.m. on KENW-TV.

“Basquiat: Rage to Riches” focuses on Jean-Michel Basquiat, a rock star of the early ’80s New York art scene, where he created thousands of drawings and paintings. It took less than a decade for Basquiat, an accountant’s son from Brooklyn, to go from anonymous graffiti writer known as SAMO© to an epoch-defining art star.

Today, Basquiat is in the top tier of the international art market along with Picasso and de Kooning. His work exhibits in museums all over the world and commands millions. 2018 marks the 30th anniversary of his untimely death from a heroin overdose.

Basquiat’s most intimate friends, lovers, and fellow artists draw a portrait of a handsome, charismatic, and fragile personality—also divulging the cash, drugs, and pernicious racism that he encountered. The main weapon Basquiat used to fight prejudice was his art.

Gandhi’s Awakening is one of the first two major documentaries about Mahatma Gandhi made in the U.S. It depicts the fascinating 21 years of Gandhi’s life known only by scholars until now, and answers the question: Who was the Mahatma before he was the Mahatma (Great Soul)? On the eve of the 150th anniversary of his birth (2019), the sequel, **Gandhi’s Gift**, is about his final, tragic and triumphant years.

Gandhi’s Awakening documents the transformative years of the young British-trained Indian attorney in South Africa, where he faces prejudice and hatred as an immigrant. Gandhi’s epiphany comes in 1906 when he volunteers as an Ambulance Driver for the British during what they call the “Zulu Rebellion.” There he faces war, its injury and its devastation up close, driving him to choose nonviolence as his lifelong path.

As he nonviolently opposes antiimmigrant practices and laws in South Africa, he is nearly killed several times for his efforts, when he leaves to return to India to begin his famous fight for freedom in 1914. Gandhi’s revolutionary nonviolent method to fight injustice and oppression will later be adopted by millions around the globe.

Gandhi’s Gift documents Gandhi at the end of his life, on the brink of attaining his lifelong goal of freedom from the British, but broken hearted by the partition of India and terrible communal violence that killed an estimated million or more.

Having led masses in non-violent marches, Gandhi now in his 70s, walks alone for unity and peace. In a dangerous pilgrimage called “The Miracle of

Noakhali,” he walks barefoot from village-to-village asking Hindus and Muslims to live together in peace when he is assassinated by religious extremists in 1948.

Gandhi’s Gift reveals inspiring details about his final years and timeless message of nonviolence, equality, and interfaith harmony. More than two dozen historians and witnesses tell Gandhi’s story, including his grandson, Dr. Rajmohan Gandhi, and author James W. Douglass (*Gandhi and The Unspeakable: His Final Experiment With Truth*).

The two-part series **Gandhi’s Awakening** and **Gandhi’s Gift** airs on 3-2 Sundays at 10:00 a.m. beginning the 2nd and Sundays at 9:00 p.m. beginning the 9th. On 3-1, the programs air Mondays at 7:00 p.m. beginning the 3rd and Tuesdays at 2:00 p.m. beginning the 4th.

Along the way, Rick visits poignant sights throughout Europe relating to fascism, and talks with Europeans whose families lived through those times.

The goal of the **Rick Steves Special** is to learn from the hard lessons of 20th-century Europe, and to recognize that ideology in the 21st century.

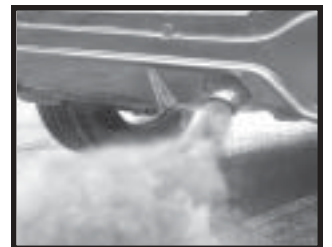

Backfired: When VW Lied to America tells the inside story of how clean air regulators led by Dan Carder and his grad students

The program reveals how VW’s top executives lied, cheated, and knowingly poisoned the world for 10 years in a ruthless quest for power, profit, and absolute domination of the world’s auto markets. The unprecedented fines VW paid will accelerate efforts to decarbonize the world and reduce greenhouse gases.

The Mayo Clinic: Faith—Hope—Science

The Mayo Clinic: Faith—Hope—Science is a timely look at how one institution has met the changing demands of healthcare for 150 years. The two-hour Ken Burns presentation features the voices of Tom Hanks, Sam Waterston, Blythe Danner, and Josh Lucas as it explores what it means to “Put the Needs of the Patient First.”

After traveling throughout the Midwest looking for a place to practice, William Worrall Mayo, an English immigrant, settled with his family in rural Minnesota. When a deadly tornado tore through their small community in 1883, the Mayos took charge of recovery efforts, enlisting the help of the nearby Sisters of Saint Francis to care for patients. Afterwards, Mother Alfred Moes, the leader of the convent, told Dr. Mayo she had a vision from God that instructed her to build a hospital, with him as its director. She believed it would become “world renowned for its medical arts.”

Together with the Sisters of Saint Francis and his sons, Will and Charlie, Mayo laid the foundation for a medical center that now treats over a million patients every year from 50 states and 150 countries, and employs 64,000 people in Rochester and at campuses in Jacksonville, Florida and Scottsdale, Arizona.

“When the Mayo Clinic began in the late 19th century, the medical community was so amazed at its success, they dubbed it ‘The Miracle in the Cornfield,’” said co-director Erik Ewers. “But as unique

as Mayo may be, it’s not a miracle. It’s about incredibly determined and compassionate men and women who came together to figure out how to create a model of care that puts patients before profits.”

In addition to interviews with patients Tom Brokaw, John McCain, and the Dalai Lama, a series of case studies reveals patients, doctors, and nurses in their most private moments as together they face difficult diagnoses and embark on uncertain treatments. The film follows the stories of many who have come to the Clinic looking for answers—and hope:

- Abigail Feenstra, a toddler from Utah who is treated in Scottsdale for a brain tumor using a state-of-the-art proton beam that avoids damaging healthy tissue;
- Karl Schenk, a patient from South Dakota with advanced pancreatic cancer, who doctors treat with a unique combination of surgery and chemotherapy that challenges conventional assumptions about the possibility of long-term remission;
- Roger Frisch, a concert violinist whose career is threatened by an uncontrollable tremor until a Mayo doctor in Rochester cures it by using experimental deep-brain stimulation.

The final seven episodes of **The Great American Read** begin with the “Fall Kick Off” in September that introduces the list of the 100 best-loved books. Thereafter, each episode highlights some of the country’s 100 favorite novels, each organized around a particular theme.

The next episode explores the ways that America’s best-loved novels answer the



age-old question, “Who Am I?” From life lessons to spiritual journeys, these books help us understand our own identities. Books highlighted include “A Prayer for Owen Meany,” “A Separate Peace,” “A Tree Grows in Brooklyn,” “The

Catcher in the Rye,” “Ghost,” “Jane Eyre,” “The Outsiders,” “Siddhartha,” “Tales of the City,” and “To Kill a Mockingbird.”

Then, follow the trials and tribulations of some of literature’s favorite “Heroes.” Books highlighted include “1984,” “A Confederacy of Dunces,” “The Alex Cross Series,” “Catch 22,” “Charlotte’s Web,” “Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time” “Don Quixote,” “The Help,” “The Giver,” “The Hunger Games,” “The Hunt for Red October” and “The Invisible Man.”

The themes of books to be highlighted in October are “Villains and Monsters,” “What We Do For Love,” and “Other Worlds.”

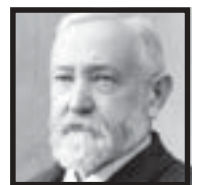
A President at the Crossroads

A President at the Crossroads details the life and dualities of Benjamin Harrison, the 23rd president of the United States. He was a war hero and champion of veterans. He was cold in one-on-one conversations, but a brilliant lawyer and orator. In the area of conservation, he was a visionary, in foreign affairs, foresighted, and in his personal life, unconventional.

Harrison was an early architect of a social safety net, and he signed landmark anti-trust legislation that is still on the books today. However, he also presided over growing income inequality and supported domestic legislation that likely contributed to the economic collapse of 1893. Both were factors that cost Harrison another term.

Historians examine Harrison’s formative years, his time in office, and his life after the presidency. Viewers are afforded a look at both the public and private lives of a man who stood at the crossroads between the past and the modern world.

It covers the homefront during WWII and the early days of Mardi Gras and the city's musical, culinary, and literary history.
