PAINTING SANTA FE

Focusing on the founding of the Santa Fe Arts Colony, **Painting Santa Fe** tells the fascinating history of Santa Fe's transformation from an adobe village to a world-renowned center for the arts. The film celebrates the history, culturally-diverse artists, institutions, and patrons of this unique place and chapter in American art.

Over the centuries, Santa Fe has gone through many transformations—from a colonial capital on El Camino Real, to a trade capital with the Santa Fe Trail, to its present incarnation—an international arts capital with a strong cultural identity and artistic legacy.

There are numerous artists and community people who are important to the story of **Painting Santa Fe**. The film highlights approximately the first two decades of Santa Fe's arts colony, from 1904, when Carlos Vierra arrives, to the early 1930s. It was during this time that the city witnessed the arrival of artists, many seeking a cure for tuberculosis.

These early years include the arrival of Edgar Lee Hewett, a visionary and cultural entrepreneur, who had a profound impact on art as it developed in New Mexico. Art then

played a profound role in transforming the economically depressed city of Santa Fe.

The later part of the film features an in-depth look into the artists themselves, for whom the city became a broad canvas. It celebrates the contributions of Los Cinco Pintores, Carlos Vierra, Robert Henri, Gerald Cassidy, Olive Rush, John Sloan, Randall Davey, and many others.

Painting Santa Fe can be seen on 3-2 Friday, the 1st at 9:00 p.m., Sunday, the 3rd at 10:00 a.m., and Sunday, the 24th at 6:00 p.m. On 3-1, it airs Thursday, the 7th at 7:00 a.m. and Sunday, the 17th at 9:00 p.m.

Genius of the Ancient World

In **Genius of the Ancient World**, a three-part series,



historian Bettany Hughes travels to India, Greece, and China to investigate the lives of three of history's greatest philosophers: Buddha, Socrates, and Confucius. While these ancient trailblazers were born thousands of miles apart, they all lived between the 6th and 4th centuries B.C., a period of worldwide economic growth, societal upheaval, and intellectual development. Their radical ideas forever changed the way we think about crucial existential and socio-political questions. They embodied the shift away from supernatural beliefs in favor of logical reasoning.

In his 20s, the Buddha abandoned his privileged family home in the foothills of the Himalayas to embark on an ambitious philosophical quest: to find a solution to human suffering. Although he sought out the most revered teachers, it was only when he found his own way that he finally attained enlightenment—nirvana: a state of being where all delusion, desire, and suffering were extinguished.

Socrates was born during a tumultuous period of

Greek history. Athens had given birth to democracy, and was a hotbed of new philosophical ideas. Socrates would become, arguably, its most vocal and charismatic thinker. But by challenging tradition and convention, Socrates also made enemies. Eventually, he was put on trial, found guilty, and sentenced to drink deadly hemlock.

Confucius is considered the first Chinese thinker to take a systematic, philosophical approach to the social, political, and moral challenges of his world. He commandeered rituals and traditions of the past to form a compelling philosophical vision. He tried to instill his principles of moral excellence in China's elite. Although he died without seeing his vision for his nation come to pass, his philosophies would eventually form the bedrock of Chinese culture.

Fine art sleuthing is the name of the game on **The Art Detectives**. Dr. Bendor Grosvenor and social historian Emma Dabiri delve into Britain's local museums and country houses to look for lost and hidden treasures. Together they discover the unique stories behind the paintings and restore them for public enjoyment.

The four-part series includes a range of destinations, from Pollok House in Glasgow to the famous Derby museum, and features works credited to artists such as Peter Paul Rubens, Antonis Mor, and Mary Beale.

Man in an Orange Shirt

A remarkable cast headed by Oscar-winner Vanessa Redgrave portrays a pair of love stories, sixty years apart, linked by family ties, sexual identity, and a mysterious painting, in “Man in an Orange Shirt,” airing in a single two-hour presentation on **Masterpiece**.

The plot opens near the Italian front at the end of World War II. British Captain Michael Berryman (Oliver Jackson-Cohen) saves the life of a fellow officer and recognizes him as Thomas March, an old schoolmate. Though engaged to his childhood sweetheart, Flora, Michael feels a powerful attraction to Thomas, who feels the same way.

After the war, Michael looks up Thomas in London, and they spend a weekend at Michael’s rundown country cottage. There, Thomas sketches

Michael for a painting that will become “Man in an Orange Shirt.”

In an era when homosexuality in England was punished by prison, there is no hope of living together. Furthermore, Michael feels honor-bound to marry Flora.

The second half of the drama skips two generations to the present day. Michael and Thomas have died, and Flora (Redgrave) lives with her grandson, Adam (Julian Morris), a young veterinarian active in London’s gay scene. Into Adam’s restless life comes an architect eager for a stable relationship and intrigued by the challenge of fixing up the cottage that Adam has been given by Flora—the same one where Michael and Thomas spent a weekend six decades earlier.

Times change and laws change, but the problem of love, commitment, and acceptance is as formidable as ever. It’s not just Adam who faces this dilemma. So does Flora, for she has unfinished business with the past.

Göring’s Secret— The Story of Hitler’s Marshall

A newly unearthed collection of personal film reels provide an uncensored look at the private life of Hermann Göring, Hitler’s second-in-command. Nobody knew that Göring had such a secret passion for film.

Göring’s Secret—The Story of Hitler’s Marshall reveals footage of Göring as he preferred to see himself: as a powerful leader adored by the masses; as Commander-in-Chief of the Luftwaffe; and as Hitler’s most important confidant. Eventually sentenced to death at the Nuremberg Trials, Göring took his own life with a poison capsule before the sentence was carried out.

How could the highly decorated World War I pilot become such a ruthless and corrupt stooge of Hitler’s? **Göring’s Secret** addresses that question and many others.

Ohiyesa: The Soul of an Indian follows Kate Beane, an urban Dakota scholar, and her family as they retrace the footsteps of their celebrated relative, Ohiyesa.

Ohiyesa, also known as Charles Eastman, lived an extraordinary life during a tumultuous time for the Dakota Oyate (nation). Born in 1858, Ohiyesa was part of the last generation of his family to inherit and be raised with the full knowledge of traditional Dakota life in Minnesota.

As a child, he was forced out of the state with his community following the Dakota War of 1862.

He grew up to graduate from Dartmouth, and became only the second Native American physician in the United States. Eastman’s other roles included that of lecturer on the international stage, important author, social activist, and Native American advocate, all before his people were considered American citizens in their own land.
