LIONS STAY IN TOP TEN; UP TO 8th

- The Lions are now ranked No. 8 in the nation in Division II according to the American Football Coaches Association Coaches Poll this week.
- A&M-Commerce has now been ranked in 22 straight AFCA polls, dating back to the 2015 preseason poll.
- This is A&M-Commerce's 28th all-time appearance in the AFCA poll since its inception in 2000.

HOOKS' RETURNS SPARK LIONS



- Last week's front page story in the game notes was punting. This week, it's punt returning.
- Shawn Hooks won Lone Star Conference Special Teams Player of the Week honors thanks to a 54-yard punt return for a touchdown in the 62-14 win at Angelo State.
- This is the fifth time in seven chances that the Lions have taken the Special Teams Player of the Week award.
- Hooks has now worked his way up to fifth nationally in the punt return average standings and leads the LSC.

BACK-TO-BACK CONTINUED

• Of the nine players to return two punts for touchdowns this season, Hooks is one of three to do it in consecutive games.

• Of note, Trinity's Jordan Williams returned two punts for touchdowns in just the third quarter of the Tigers' 38-17 win at Austin College last Saturday. However, these were both 10-yard returns of blocked punts.

DOMINGUEZ LEADS LSC IN PUNTING



• A&M-Commerce punter Hector Dominguez didn't have a statistically dominant game at Angelo State, though his boot in the third quarter led to a fumble recovery for a touchdown.

• He is still the leading punter in the Lone Star Conference and is ranked 12th nationally in punting average.

• As a team, the Lions rank sixth nationally in net punting at 39.14 yards net.

• A&M-Commerce has also been exceptional on punt return defense, allowing an average of 1.64 yards per punt return.

• Against WNMU on Oct. 15, Dominguez had four punts for an average of 60.25 yards in Silver City to win LSC Special Teams Player of the Week honors for the second time this season. Dominguez had punts of 70, 54, 57, and 60 yards.

• He is also the only punter in all four NCAA football divisions to average over 60 yards per punt with more than two punts in a game this season.

• It is the first time a Division II punter averaged over 60 yards per punt with more than two punts in a game in seven years

• Oklahoma Panhandle State's Brian Holman averaged 61.25 yards on four punts vs. Southern Nazarene on Nov. 7, 2009.

• That was 72 regular season weeks ago.

HANGIN' WITH MR. COOPER



• Running back Richard Cooper has continued his march upwards in the all-time A&M-Commerce rushing record books.

• He is now the league leader in rushing average - both per game and per carry.

• Cooper ranks 15th nationally in rushing yards per game (114.1 yards per game) and 18th in rushing yards per carry (6.50 yards per carry).

• He is also only 31 yards away from becoming the fifth 3,000-yard career rusher in the fantastic history of Lion football.

THE HOG MOLLIES

- In addition to blocking for one of the nation's top rushers and the one of the top offenses in the Lone Star Conference, the Lion offensive line has prided itself on its protection of Perez.
- The Lions rank 6th nationally in sacks allowed per game (0.57), with four total sacks allowed.

WINNING THE TURNOVER BATTLE

- The Lions plus-five turnover margin in the rout at Angelo State put them back near the top of the NCAA standings in turnover margin.
- A&M-Commerce ranks fourth nationally with a plus-1.71 margin per game.

ALL-TIME AGAINST THE BUFFS

- The Lions have a 16-14 all-time lead in the series against WT.
- The 2014 win for the Lions snapped a six-year losing streak to WT and A&M-Commerce regained the series lead.
- The Lions are 9-6 all-time in Commerce.
- Between Colby Carthel's tenure in Commerce and that of his father - Don - as the head coach at WT, this is the 10th straight meeting with a Carthel as a head coach in the matchup.

CARTHEL FIFTH IN SCHOOL HISTORY IN WINS

- Head coach Colby Carthel now ranks fifth in A&M-Commerce history in coaching wins with 31 wins.
- However, he will be in fifth for a while, as his 31 wins are half of J.V. Sikes' 63 wins in fourth place.

- 1977 - The Lions head to San Marcos and drop a 34-20 loss to Southwest Texas.
- 1983 - ETSU falls to Southwest Texas 44-21 in San Marcos.
- 1988 - The Lions pick up their fifth straight win with a 39-24 victory at Abilene Christian.
- 1994 - East Texas travels westwards and earns a 42-35 win at Abilene Christian.
- 2005 - The Lions are edged by West Texas A&M 19-17 at Memorial Stadium.
- 2011 - A&M-Commerce drops a 40-28 loss to No. 19 Abilene Christian on the road.

... in college football history : October 29, 1921: Centre (Ky.) def. Harvard, 6-0, in Boston. Harvard entered this game with a 25-game unbeaten streak, including a 7-6 win over Oregon in the 1920 Rose Bowl and a 31-14 win over Centre the year before. In front of 43,000 fans in Harvard Stadium, the Colonels of Centre College, boasting a total enrollment of 254 students, shocked the country. College Football Hall of Fame quarterback Bo McMillin scored the game's only touchdown, a 33-yard scramble in the third quarter. In 2006, ESPN Classic declared Centre's win the third-biggest upset in college football history. The "Praying Colonels" finished the 1921 season as Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Association Co-Champions with a 10-1 record after a loss to Texas A&M in the Dixie Classic.

... in world history :

- 1792 – Mount Hood (Oregon) is named after Samuel Hood, 1st Viscount Hood by Lt. William E. Broughton who sighted the mountain near the mouth of the Willamette River.
- 1863 – Eighteen countries meet in Geneva and agree to form the International Red Cross.
- 1923 – Turkey becomes a republic following the dissolution of the Ottoman Empire.
- 1929 – The New York Stock Exchange crashes in what will be called the Crash of '29 or "Black Tuesday", ending the Great Bull Market of the 1920s and beginning the Great Depression.
- 1960 – In Louisville, Kentucky, Cassius Clay (who later takes the name Muhammad Ali) wins his first professional fight.
- 1969 – The first-ever computer-to-computer link is established on ARPANET, the precursor to the Internet.
- 1998 – Space Shuttle Discovery blasts off on STS-95 with 77-year-old John Glenn on board, making him the oldest person to go into space. ATSC HDTV broadcasting in the United States is inaugurated with the launch of the same STS-95 space shuttle mission.

2016 TEXAS A&M-COMMERCE FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

HEAD COACH COLBY CARTHEL

Colby Carthel was hired as the 19th head coach in A&M-Commerce history on January 23, 2013.

In his third season of 2015, Carthel led the Lions to their second straight and 22nd overall Lone Star Conference regular-season title. A&M-Commerce went 8-4 on the year and earned the seventh seed in the NCAA Division II Playoffs, advancing to the NCAA postseason for the first time since 1995. The Lions dropped their first round game at second-seeded Ferris State, 48-30.

With an undefeated LSC regular season, the Lions clinched their second consecutive conference title on October 24 with a win over Midwestern State. Postseason honors were many, as A&M-Commerce earned a school-record 27 all-LSC honors. The Lions also collected three All-American awards. Richard Cooper was named the LSC Offensive Back of the Year.

In his second season, the Carthel-led 2014 Lions turned in one of the best seasons in recent A&M-Commerce history. The Lions reeled off a nine-win season en route to the program's 21st LSC Championship and made a second consecutive postseason appearance with a trip to the Heart of Texas Bowl which the Lions won 72-21 over East Central.

The Lions saw a then-school record 26 players earn LSC post-season recognition, including conference wide receiver of the year Vernon Johnson and defensive player of the year Toni Pulu. The Lions opened the season with 98 points and a NCAA record 986 total yards offense. The pace saw the Lions end the season with the NCAA's No. 1 offense in terms of total yards per game and scoring per game.

Carthel led the Lions to a 7-5 record in his first season at the helm, a far cry from the combined 5-26 record the team put up in the three seasons prior to his arrival. That turnaround, one that included wins over nationally-ranked Delta State and Tarleton State, earned the Lions a postseason berth in the Live United Texarkana Bowl – the program's first postseason berth since qualifying for the national playoffs in 1995.

Although previously a defensive coordinator, the Lions made huge strides on the offensive side of the ball in his first season, averaging 35.0 points per game, which was up 22.4 points per game from the previous year and was the most by a Lion team since the 1990 team averaged 36.2 per game.

The Lions also garnered 15 all-Lone Star Conference selections in 2013, including three on the first team. Defensive lineman Charles Tuauu was named the league's top defender and earned all-America honors, while Vernon Johnson was named the league's top wide receiver after a season that saw him haul in over 1,300 yards and 13 scores through the air.

Carthel came to Commerce with strong ties to the Lone Star Conference, spending the seven previous seasons as the defensive coordinator at West Texas A&M and playing a key role in establishing the Buffs as one of the top teams in the region. During his seven years at West Texas A&M, the Buffs captured four Lone Star Conference championships while making an appearance in the postseason each year, including a pair of Kanza Bowl championships and a regional championship in 2012.

During Carthel's tenure as the Buffs' defensive coordinator, West Texas A&M compiled a 69-20 record with a 77.5 winning percentage.
