LIONS STAY IN TOP TEN; STAY IN 8th

- The Lions remain ranked No. 8 in the nation in Division II according to the American Football Coaches Association Coaches Poll this week.
- A&M-Commerce has now been ranked in 24 straight AFCA polls, dating back to the 2015 preseason poll.
- This is A&M-Commerce's 30th all-time appearance in the AFCA poll since its inception in 2000.
- The Lions also held steady at No. 7 in the D2Football.com rankings.

A&M-COMMERCE 4th IN SUPER REGION

- The Lions are ranked fourth in the third release of this year's Super Region Four rankings, as announced by the NCAA Division II Football Committee on Monday.
- The Lions stay in the top four of the regional rankings, which remained unchanged. Undefeated Grand Valley State still holds the top spot in the region, while Midwestern State is second and Southwest Baptist is third.
- Truman State is now in fifth place, followed by Ferris State in sixth, Colorado Mesa in seventh, Colorado Mines in eighth, Ashland in ninth and Colorado State-Pueblo in 10th.
- This is the final regular season publication

this season of the Super Region rankings, which are officially used by the NCAA Division II Football Committee to select the playoff field on Sunday, November 13. The top seven teams from each of Division II's four Super Regions will qualify for the playoffs.

- The first seed will receive a bye to the second round, while the second, third and fourth seeds would host first round games.

CARTHEL 5TH IN SCHOOL HISTORY IN WINS

- Head coach Colby Carthel now ranks fifth in A&M-Commerce history in coaching wins with 32 wins.
- However, he will be in fifth for a while, as his 31 wins are half of J.V. Sikes' 63 wins in fourth place.

THE HOG MOLLIES

- In addition to blocking for one of the nation's top rushers and the one of the top offenses in the Lone Star Conference, the Lion offensive line has prided itself on its protection of Perez.
- The Lions now rank 3rd nationally in sacks allowed per game (0.44), with four total sacks allowed.
- A&M-Commerce has not allowed a sack in the last three games, dating back to the Western New Mexico game.

KINCADE SCOOPS PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS



- Reggie Kincade was named Lone Star Conference Special Teams Player of the Week for his efforts in the 58-21 win UT Permian Basin.
- Kincade – a sophomore from Everman - was all over the field on special teams in the Lions' 58-21 rout of UTPB with two key recoveries.

• In the first quarter, he recovered a fumble on a kickoff return and gave the Lions the ball at the Falcon 14. On the next drive, Kincade recovered a blocked punt and returned it 15 yards for a touchdown to put the Lions up 21-0.

SCORELESS STREAK ENDS AFTER MORE THAN 2 HOURS

- A second quarter touchdown by UT Permian Basin snapped a Lion defensive scoreless streak of more than two hours.
- The Lions did not allow a point from late in the first quarter at Angelo State until the 11:13 mark of the second quarter at UTPB.
- The streak totaled 131 minutes and 48 seconds with eight full quarters of scoreless football.

HANGIN' WITH MR. COOPER



- Running back Richard Cooper has continued his march upwards in the all-time A&M-Commerce rushing record books.
- He is now the league leader in rushing average - both per game and per carry.

• Cooper ranks 29th nationally in rushing yards per game (102.3 yards per game), taking a slight hit in that category after limited action at UTPB.

• He became the fifth 3,000-yard career rusher in the fantastic history of Lion football with his first quarter touchdown carry vs West Texas A&M.

- He is within reach of fourth place on the all-time rushing charts.
- He also has 15 career 100-yards rushing games after his performance vs. WT.

A LOOK AT THE PRESIDENT'S CUP RIVALRY

• A&M-Commerce and Tarleton State battle every year for the President's Cup and the Lions will look to hold onto the traveling trophy for the fourth straight year.

• The Lions are 13-11 all-time in the trophy game, with a 6-6 record at Memorial Stadium.

• The Lions have won the last four matchups (three President's Cups and an LSC Playoff game) against the Texans, rolling to a 63-0 shutout win in Stephenville last year.

• The Lions won the first eight matchups, followed by the Texans winning 11 of 12 before A&M-Commerce's recent four-game winning streak.

PEREZ CONTINUES TO IMPRESS



- Texas A&M-Commerce quarterback Luis Perez has been fantastic in his introduction to the Lion lineup.
- Perez is featured prominently in the NCAA Division II and Lone Star Conference statistical rankings
- He leads the LSC in seven categories - pass efficiency, passing touchdowns, passing yards per game, passing yards per attempt, passing yards per completion, points responsible for per game and total offense.

- After his five touchdown performance at UTPB, Perez has 26 touchdowns this season, which ranks third in a single season at A&M-Commerce - and third-most in the last three seasons.
- Tyrik Rollison had 31 passing TDs in 2015, followed by Harrison Stewart with 30 in 2015.
- At 2,528 yards, he needs 472 passing yards to become the third Lion trigger man with 3,000 passing yards in a season.

SPREADING THE LOVE

- The Lions are in the lead in the conference in interceptions as a team, picking off 17 of their opponents' passes at this point in the year.
- While this is impressive, perhaps more impressive is that 14 of the 17 interceptions have been made by a different player.
- Brent Walker's interception at Western New Mexico made him the first player to repeat this season for the Lions.
- The Lions four picks vs. West Texas A&M are their most in one game this season.
- Yusef Sterling-Lowe has had the Lions' last two picks.

2016 TEXAS A&M-COMMERCE FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

HEAD COACH COLBY CARTEL

Colby Cartel was hired as the 19th head coach in A&M-Commerce history on January 23, 2013.

In his third season of 2015, Cartel led the Lions to their second straight and 22nd overall Lone Star Conference regular-season title. A&M-Commerce went 8-4 on the year and earned the seventh seed in the NCAA Division II Playoffs, advancing to the NCAA postseason for the first time since 1995. The Lions dropped their first round game at second-seeded Ferris State, 48-30.

With an undefeated LSC regular season, the Lions clinched their second consecutive conference title on October 24 with a win over Midwestern State. Postseason honors were many, as A&M-Commerce earned a school-record 27 all-LSC honors. The Lions also collected three All-American awards. Richard Cooper was named the LSC Offensive Back of the Year.

In his second season, the Cartel-led 2014 Lions turned in one of the best seasons in recent A&M-Commerce history. The Lions reeled off a nine-win season en route to the program's 21st LSC Championship and made a second consecutive postseason appearance with a trip to the Heart of Texas Bowl which the Lions won 72-21 over East Central.

The Lions saw a then-school record 26 players earn LSC post-season recognition, including conference wide receiver of the year Vernon Johnson and defensive player of the year Toni Pulu. The Lions opened the season with 98 points and a NCAA record 986 total yards offense. The pace saw the Lions end the season with the NCAA's No. 1 offense in terms of total yards per game and scoring per game.

Cartel led the Lions to a 7-5 record in his first season at the helm, a far cry from the combined 5-26 record the team put up in the three seasons prior to his arrival. That turnaround, one that included wins over nationally-ranked Delta State and Tarleton State, earned the Lions a postseason berth in the Live United Texarkana Bowl – the program's first postseason berth since qualifying for the national playoffs in 1995.

Although previously a defensive coordinator, the Lions made huge strides on the offensive side of the ball in his first season, averaging 35.0 points per game, which was up 22.4 points per game from the previous year and was the most by a Lion team since the 1990 team averaged 36.2 per game.

The Lions also garnered 15 all-Lone Star Conference selections in 2013, including three on the first team. Defensive lineman Charles Tuauu was named the league's top defender and earned all-America honors, while Vernon Johnson was named the league's top wide receiver after a season that saw him haul in over 1,300 yards and 13 scores through the air.

Cartel came to Commerce with strong ties to the Lone Star Conference, spending the seven previous seasons as the defensive coordinator at West Texas A&M and playing a key role in establishing the Buffs as one of the top teams in the region. During his seven years at West Texas A&M, the Buffs captured four Lone Star Conference championships while making an appearance in the postseason each year, including a pair of Kanza Bowl championships and a regional championship in 2012.

During Cartel's tenure as the Buffs' defensive coordinator, West Texas A&M compiled a 69-20 record with a 77.5 winning percentage.
