I came home from prison June of '91 & she had disappeared. I asked questions and found out about Cody & her having a fight & they split up & that's about the time she disappeared.

Yes, I had been friends w/ her when she was w/ Leonard & had our good times & a couple bad ones over the men in our lives being the same ones. She was with Cody after ~~we~~ I left him. We all roomed for a minute after that & I didn't see her much when I moved away.

I am sorry that you guys have had to go through, the not knowing, & needing closure. I would love to sit down with you one day & talk about what I believe happened. But like you, I can only go by speculation. I'm sure you've run this over in your head a million



times. And trust me Carey  
would never just disappear.  
She could be a little unstable  
at times but she loved her  
children I know. But none of  
this knowledge helps anyone  
find her. If I knew where she  
was I would not hesitate to let  
you know.

If you think Cody may have  
done something... I never knew  
him to be violent + I know that  
his Mother was very protective  
of him. That woman was violent  
& she scared me a time or 2. Cody  
had to get her away from me. I  
believe though that if anything happened  
to her it was there + they had the  
means to make her disappear. I do  
know that Cody loved her because  
we had a talk one day while she  
was off running around + I told  
him to go get her + quit crying  
about it.

I think about it this way  
too. I remember how nuts she got  
with Leonard. She was homicidal  
suicidal. So, I just don't know  
anything that can help you more



than what you know.

Anyways... I am sorry that I can't help you anymore than this. And I pray that one day someone learns something. It is very sad. I remember her children wish they didn't have to wonder about her. I just know she loved them + I hope they know that she would never have ~~not~~ left them like that. That is very important for them to know in their lives. I know it would be for me.

If you have any specific questions or even want to keep in touch with me, you know where I am. I don't think they are going to let me go until my cancer stuff is clear so I'm here for another year at least.

I don't believe we have met before, but from what I understand, you were a pretty good friend of my sister Carey Parker. Unfortunately, Carey has not been heard from since March of 1991. Our family has been struggling for almost 22 years not knowing how to find her. Our father raised her three children, who to this day are still trying to come to grips with not knowing anything about her. It has been a serious emotional roller coaster. At the time she disappeared, she had just broken up with William Cody Songer. The reason I am writing to you is because during my search for answers, I came across a guy who said that he had given you a ride one day. I don't know all of the details, but he mentioned having a discussion with you about Carey. He said you mentioned you knew where she was.

I want to assure you that all we want is to bring her home. After 22 years, not showing up to her job, not picking up her last check, not showing up to her son's planned birthday party, I know deep inside someone killed her and hid her body. At this point who did it and why is least important. The most important factor is closure.

Although you don't know me, I am pleading on behalf of myself and my family to ask if you would tell us what you know. At least give her kids a chance to move forward and cope with the loss of their mother. You have no idea how much this information could heal a hurting family. I appreciate anything you could provide to help us get closure.
