

I know every single one of those people you asked about. I grew up with them. Todd is my ex-boyfriend when I was 15. He has a brother Darren - Linda & Kathy have a sister who is now w/ Todd her name is Jerry. They were living with Todd's mom in Joyce City. But she is now in a nursing home. The last time I heard from Todd was about a year ago. He moves around.

The last time I saw Kathy she was
living at Red Hawk in the W. Tawapout
& working at Willie's restaurant. Unfortunately
I can't recall Dan Robertson. There was
a Dan who worked w/ Jim but I
don't remember his last name. And
about Cotton - he was given some
bad stuff & ended up naked on
the bridges between Turlan & Cash
& got hit by a vehicle a few years
back (like around 2008?). But he has
a brother Willie Cotton. He races
cars on occasion & lives on 34 out
toward Cash. About Todd - he's okay.
He's burned out from all the heroine
& pills. He's not the same person
I was crazy about in high school.

Wish you & I should be about
the same age. I'm 43 born Oct. 10, 1969.
Oh - Todd is how I met Carey & Leonard.
All of those people were into pills
& drinking. There's one you name it. Then
I strayed off & got into Meth on
an extreme level & left them behind.
I still saw them sometimes & Todd
always was my pit stop. He's been
a captain save a horse for me a time
or 3. A place to stay - someone to
rescue me when I get stranded
some where. You name it he's been
there.

Anyways, my daughter finally
wrote me. I was happy about that.
But the circumstances behind it
passed me off. I asked my boyfriend
to mail a card & \$20 to her from
me. He kept talking about his coming
w/ him to see me & I told him that
was not happening more than once.
Yet when he sends the card he

writes her a letter asking her if
she wanted to come see me with him.
I haven't ever introduced them because
I don't like people coming in & out
of her life. My life is different.
But she is more important to me
than that. I told him when I came
home he'd meet everyone then. Yet
he didn't respect that so now I'm
highly upset. My ex husband is
speaking out on it too. I understand
the guy wants to be a part of my
future life but doing stuff like
that is not how to go about that
situation. I wrote him as nice a
letter as possible on that subject.
I don't want him not to be accepted
by my people & I hope he didn't
screw that up. He's a good person
he takes care of me. They do more
than I can ever ask for. But
that was way out of line. I still
don't even know how to feel about
that. I just had to get that off
my mind. Thanks for listening & I
will... Gonna get this in the
mail so you can get your stamps
back & my mail.

I just wrote to put you on
my visitation list. I will probably
have to fill out a form but I don't
have one so I sent an I-loo (like an IOC)
to visitation to let them know. You
should be on there soon. I'll keep
you informed.

Hey Stacey!

I have not forgotten you; sorry it took me longer than I anticipated getting back with you. Today is only Tuesday, but it looks like it will be a busy week!! I was glad I received your letter. I completely forgot how much you have to conserve stamps and other items. I am sorry I should have realized that, but I guess not being in certain situations we tend to forget. I am going to send you stamps so you don't have to worry.

The location you described of the .34 acres is the same location I was talking about that is still in Cody's relatives names. They also owned the additional scrap yard property up until 1997 according to my research. But I was already sure they did because .34 acres is not enough land for a building and all equipment and materials to run a septic business. Some other people have commented they wondered why the Songer's just up and left... Do you remember where you heard they were digging? Like way out back, off the road etc.?

Unfortunately, the detectives won't even bother looking without something or someone with direct knowledge. Without this they cannot get a search warrant. I know that we will probably never get that and it makes me real sad... I know deep down that Cody knows something too. But I am sure he would never fess up to it either. When they lived out on the property, was it a metal building back then? I can't remember... I was never on the property, just remember passing it going to Rockwall when I was younger.

To be honest, I don't really know who threatened my father. I heard it was someone named Dan Robertson, but I don't recall my father actually telling me who. I am going to see him again soon and I will ask him. Not sure what I will find out from him now since his dementia is pretty bad. ☹️ I was wondering if you knew a Todd Langford. I have heard that name from two different people in two completely different conversations, so I was curious if you knew him and could tell me a little about him. I also heard Carey hung around with a woman named Kathy Choates and her sister's name was Vonda who was married to a Cotton Carey was staying with. Do you know any of these people.

Let me know when you are able to add me and I will come see you. Are there specific days and hours for visitors? Are you only permitted a certain amount of visitors per week? I will call in advance before coming anyway. You mentioned in your previous letter you were being treated for cancer. How bad is it and what kind? Will they be able to remove it all with the treatment you are receiving? How long have you been sick? Sorry for all the questions. I really am interested. I am a very caring person. Our mother was sick as long as I could remember from MS. Growing up taking care of a sick parent makes you grow into a whole different person, with a completely different outlook on life than most.

I remember when I was 15 and 16 nobody could tell me anything! I was Miss Know It All for real! Your daughter will come around. I am sure she is probably missing her mama right now. Thanksgiving was pretty good. I stayed home and cooked. Can you believe Carey's youngest is 24 now and Brian is 27?? Where does time go?
