The Commerce City Council met in a public workshop on January 23, 2013 to discuss several topics, including the future of the Public Swimming Pool. The pool was closed in mid-season last summer due to maintenance issues surrounding the pump. A detailed report was provided to Council outlining the repairs needed and the costs involved in making such repairs.

The Commerce City Council Members took into consideration not only the extensive costs involved in repairing the facility, but the entertainment that it provides to the citizens, especially the children, of this community. However, due to the high price tag required to repair and maintain the pool, it is unfortunate that the City will not be able to fund the needed repairs and will be permanently closing the Commerce City Pool.

Council has yet to determine what will happen to the current facility but did indicate that other water venues are being considered.
