**POST-EXAMINATION COMPETENCY HEARING ORDER**

Now on this 10th day of December, 2015, the State appears by First Assistant District Attorney Kevin Etherington, and the Defendant, Adacia Avery Chambers, appears in person and with her attorney, Tony Coleman.


On the 9th day of November, 2015, the Defendant was ordered to be evaluated by the Oklahoma Forensic Center. Criminal proceedings were suspended until such time as the evaluation was completed. Upon receipt of a psychiatric evaluation of the defendant prepared by Scott Orth, Psy.D., a post-examination competency hearing was held on December 10th, 2015.

WHEREUPON, the Court, after reviewing the above mentioned written psychiatric evaluation dated November 24th, 2015, finds as follows:



- (1) That the Defendant is competent to undergo further criminal proceedings at this time;
- (2) That the defendant is able to appreciate the nature of the charges against her;

- (3) That the Defendant is able to consult with her attorneys and rationally assist in the preparation of her defense.
- (4) That the Defendant is not a mentally retarded person or a person requiring treatment as defined by Sec. I-I-3 of Title 43-A of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- (5) That if the defendant is not presently dangerous, but would likely benefit from continued medication and treatment compliance, and monitoring throughout her adjudicative process.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Court that these criminal proceedings shall be resumed.
