3. List and Description of Longer-Term Recruitment Initiatives Implemented During the Previous Year

KGOU has 14 full time employees, including three who work in the journalism collaboration, StateImpact Oklahoma. As of January 31, 2018, two full time positions are vacant. One of them is in the process of being filled; the other has been left open.

A. College Intern/Practicum Program:

Date: February 1, 2017 – January 31, 2018 at the KGOU Radio Offices and Studios, Copeland Hall, Room 300, The University of Oklahoma, Norman, Oklahoma.

Description: Expose college students to the broadcasting environment and provide them skills and experiences. The internships/practicum focused on the areas of audio production, announcing, and station operations.

Scope of Involvement: Host intern and practicum from the Gaylord College of Journalism and Mass Communication at The University of Oklahoma who are majoring in broadcasting through JMC 3011, "Practicum," for one (1) class credit. During this reporting period (Spring and Fall 2017 semesters) KGOU hosted six (6) students in these classes at a minimum of 45 hours for each student.

B. Programs with Educational Institutions Relating to Career Opportunities in Broadcasting:

Date: February 1, 2017 – January 31, 2018 at the KGOU Radio Offices and Studios, Copeland Hall, Room 300, The University of Oklahoma, Norman, Oklahoma.

Description: Expose college students to the broadcasting environment and provide them skills and experiences. The focus is strictly on news reporting instruction and students created journalism content suitable for possible airing on KGOU Radio and posting on the KGOU Radio website.

Scope of Involvement: Host students from the Gaylord College of Journalism and Mass Communication at The University of Oklahoma who are majoring in broadcasting for three

(3) class credit hour course through JMC 3653, "Radio News." During this reporting period (Spring and Fall 2017 semesters) KGOU hosted five (5) students at an annual average of 300 hours of instruction.

C. Training Program for Personnel to Acquire Skills that Could Qualify Them for Higher Level Positions/College Student Employment

Date: February 1, 2017 – January 31, 2018 at the KGOU Radio Offices and Studios, Copeland Hall, Room 300, The University of Oklahoma, Norman, Oklahoma.

Description: Expose college students to the broadcasting environment and provide them skills and experiences through part-time, paid staff positions. Students competitively applied for positions in areas of news and production. Other positions could be added as funds are available.

Scope of Involvement:

1. one news assistant position; the position is for 9-12 months and the assistant researches and produces news and public interest stories, and hosts daily on-air news segments that involve announcing of local newscasts, weather and traffic reports during news magazine programs.
2. one operations assistant position; the position is for 12 months, who writes and announces community calendar announcements for local non-profit groups in the station's service area that run each day.

Students selected work up to 20 hours per week at \$8.50-\$11.00 per hour. Students are generally selected from different areas of the University of Oklahoma. During the Spring 2017 semester KGOU had two (2) students in this program; during the Fall 2017 semester KGOU had two (2) students employed.

D. Additional Student Instruction and Outreach

D-1. On February 16, GM Dick Pryor was the keynote speaker at the Oklahoma Closeup Annual Banquet at the Holiday Inn North in Oklahoma City. Oklahoma Closeup is a week-long educational program designed to provide high school students, educators and policymakers the opportunity to come together for experiential learning about Oklahoma state government. The program partners with schools across Oklahoma; the banquet, speech and Q&A lasted two hours and was attended by about 75 students.

D-2. On June 27, KGOU hosted about 25 students and ten leaders from the Oklahoma Institute for Diversity in Journalism (OIDJ) during their week-long summer camp for high school students interested in pursuing journalism and other careers in media. Special emphasis is on students from diverse backgrounds, race and ethnicity. GM Dick Pryor

met with the students for a tour of the station and conversation about journalism and jobs in the media. The program lasted about 1.5 hours.

D-3. On December 1, GM Dick Pryor was a guest speaker for the “Hangin’ with the Pros” practical skills class for more than fifty journalism students at the Gaylord College of Journalism and Mass Communication.

E. Participation in programs designed to promote professional development, awareness and engagement

E-1. On February 21, KGOU hosted students in the 4th and 5th Grade Classic Readers Book Club students from McKinley Elementary School in Norman. GM Dick Pryor talked to the students about KGOU and gave them a station tour. The program lasted about one hour.

E-2. On March 20, KGOU hosted twelve visiting journalists from Pakistan who were participating in a journalism exchange program administered by the Gaylord College of Journalism and Mass Communication at the University of Oklahoma. GM Dick Pryor gave them a tour of the station and discussed KGOU and American journalism and public service media. The program lasted six hours.

E-3. On May 12, GM Dick Pryor was emcee for Oklahoma Civics Day at the state capitol, sponsored by Generation Citizen Oklahoma. High school students from Oklahoma City, Moore, Norman presented community service projects for judging and heard from keynote speaker, State Senator A.J. Griffin from Guthrie. The program lasted three hours.

E-4. On May 13, GM Dick Pryor delivered the convocation speech to the graduating class of the OU College of Liberal Studies at Sharp Hall.

E-5. On July 11, KGOU hosted ten journalists from Bangladesh who were participating in a journalism exchange program administered by the Gaylord College of Journalism and Mass Communication at the University of Oklahoma. GM Dick Pryor gave them a tour of the station and discussed KGOU and American journalism and public service media. The program lasted six hours.

E-6. On July 17, GM Dick Pryor was guest speaker for the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI class), “The Courts, The Press and President Trump” at the OU Forum Building in Norman. The program instructor was former Senate President Pro Tempore Cal Hobson. Pryor spoke about the role of media and the importance of informed

citizenship to a group of more than 100 adults predominantly over 60 years of age. The program lasted 2.5 hours.

E-7. On July 31, KGOU hosted ten journalists from Pakistan who were participating in a journalism exchange program administered by the Gaylord College of Journalism and Mass Communication at the University of Oklahoma. GM Dick Pryor gave them a tour of the station and discussed KGOU and American journalism and public service media. The program lasted 1.5 hours.

E-8. On August 2, GM Dick Pryor was guest speaker for the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI class), “The Courts, The Press and President Trump” at the State Regents Building in Oklahoma City. The program instructor was former Senate President Pro Tempore Cal Hobson. Pryor spoke about the role of media and the importance of informed citizenship to a group of more than 100 adults predominantly over 60 years of age. The program lasted 2.5 hours.

E-9. On September 9, GM Dick Pryor represented KGOU at the 2017 Global Citizen Awards Gala at the Embassy Suites Oklahoma City/Downtown. The program recognized leaders who have made an impact in promoting global citizenship. The keynote speaker was Ramu Damodaran, Chief, United Nations Academic Impact Initiative and Deputy Director, Partnerships and Public Engagement, UN-DPI.

E-10. On September 18, KGOU hosted Pakistani/Urdu journalists who are on a state-department sponsored exchange trip to Oklahoma administered by the Gaylord College. GM Dick Pryor spoke to them about KGOU and public service journalism and Jacob McClelland and Nomin Ujjiyediin participated in the station tour. Ten journalists and 2 interpreters participated. The program lasted 1.5 hours.

E-11. On October 20, GM Dick Pryor served as master of ceremonies for the Seventh Annual NextGen Under 30 Awards Ceremonies, at the Embassy Suites Conference Center in Norman. The keynote addresses were delivered by former Oklahoma governor and OU regent Frank Keating, who was presented by Chancellor of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, Glen Johnson. The ceremony honored 189 young professionals under the age of 30 for their accomplishments in professional fields including Arts, Education, Energy, Finance, Healthcare, Hospitality, Law, Manufacturing, Industry, Agriculture, Media, Non-Profit Organizations, Policy and Public Service, Public Relations, Marketing, Advertising, Retail and E-Commerce, Science, Technology, Engineering, Sports and Fitness and Tribal Government Gaming. Attendance was approximately 900. The program will air statewide on OETA, KOTV in Tulsa and KWTW in Oklahoma City.

F. Participation in job fairs by station personnel who have substantial responsibility in the making of hiring decisions

F-1. On March 30, KGOU participated in the Oklahoma Association of Broadcasters (OAB) Career Fair at the Skirvin Hotel in Oklahoma City. There were 157 students in attendance representing thirteen Oklahoma colleges and universities.
