

News Department Internship

An internship in the KUNC Newsroom offers students the opportunity to be directly involved in the reporting, writing, production and voicing of news segments to be broadcast to a weekly audience of nearly 150,000 people.

- Spring and Fall Internships will focus on both spot news and feature-length reporting. Stories will be assigned by the News Director and may include breaking stories or those that require evening or weekend coverage.
- A weekly schedule will be determined between the intern and KUNC News Director. Please note that with the nature of working in an active news department the amount of hours per week may exceed the average.
- Interns will be required to be at the KUNC studios a minimum of two days per week for the first month of the internship. After that a once a week visit will be required. Interns may also work remotely and from KUNC's Denver Bureau based on coverage needs and schedule.
- KUNC will provide interns with all recording equipment. This equipment is to be used strictly for internship purposes and will be returned in good working order at the end of the internship period.
- Interns seeking college credit will be required to fulfill all requirements as mandated by their department prior to beginning the internship. It's the intern's responsibility to provide KUNC with all evaluation forms in a timely manner so the department can receive our recommendation for a grade.
- In addition to the work in the News Department, interns would be given an overview of station operations and the opportunity to have informational meetings with other Department Directors and the General Manager.
