

- The first Hispanic-led public radio station in the U.S., KUVU signed on the air in August **1985**.
- Broadcasting across Colorado from Denver and Vail as well as a transmitter in Breckenridge, **106,000** listeners tune in to KUVU/KVJZ every week, **7,000** of which are listener-members.
- KUVU has **59,000** social media fans (growing daily!), **30,000+** monthly website visits, **11,000** e-newsletter subscribers and **2,000** KUVU App users.
- The station airs **17** locally produced programs.
- Available world-wide through internet streaming and the KUVU App, KUVU broadcasts **3** separate streams:
 1. KUVU - The station's main daily broadcast – available both on the air and online – brings you the very best in jazz, Latin jazz and blues as well as locally produced cultural programs.
 2. KUVU HD2 - Binging listeners Jazz with Bob Parlocha, this channel also broadcasts innovative programs produced by National Public Radio, the British Broadcasting Corporation and Public Radio International.
 3. KUVU HD3 - Featuring an eclectic mix of diverse music 24/7 – both over the airwaves and online – you'll hear folk, bluegrass, Celtic/World, ambient/chill, electronica, blues, progressive country and modern jazz.
- More than **3,400** young musicians have jammed in the Phyllis A. Greer Performance Studio over the past **19** years as part of KUVU's High School/Collegiate Series, which broadcasts live performances of local up-and-coming musicians every month during the school year.
- In 2014, KUVU's volunteers donated **15,572** hours of their time to the station, answering phones during pledge drives, performing clerical duties and representing the station at more than **30** community events.
- KUVU's weekend and evening on-air hosts - totaling **45** in number - are all community volunteers, generously donating their time for the love of the music!
- KUVU has produced **11** "Live at the Oasis" CDs recorded in the Phyllis A. Greer Performance Studio, **7** "Cancion Mexicana" CDs and the **4** CD set "Caliente: Latin Jazz with Eddie Palmieri."
- The KUVU music library contains approximately **33,150** CDs, **27,500** of which are jazz, **2,100** blues, **2,200** Latin and **1,350** other CDs.
- KUVU's music library has approximately **331,500** songs; **277,500** are jazz songs (including hard disc tunes). The average length of a jazz song is **4.5** minutes, which means KUVU's jazz music library contains more than **867** days - **2** years and **4** months - of nonstop jazz music!
- Strongly committed to investing in the community, KUVU partners with more than **95** community organizations, collaborating with a wide variety of educational, art, cultural and human rights organizations.
- More than **93%** of KUVU's annual budget comes from our members, business sponsors and friends who give in a variety of ways to support the station.
