Greg was an integral part of ONC, the Yukon-Kuskokwim Rivers, and this region. He has represented this area in Local, State, Federal, and International Natural Resources Boards and Committees. Greg's knowledge, passion, and friendship will be deeply missed.

Greg has demonstrated thru his work; that he is a strong advocate of natural resources in our region and within the State of Alaska. Greg's expertise and understanding in this area has been a positive benefit to the people of our region. Greg protected our interests, cultural values and customs, he expressed Conservation and Sustainability as his primary priority.

Greg Roczicka served on many boards, councils, committees, and commissions. He worked very closely with the natural resources of Fish & Game management for the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta since 1980.
