I understand that you sent a Right-to-Know request to my office looking for documents related to my participation on the Presidential Advisory Commission on Election Integrity. Although I view my role on the Commission as being in my personal capacity I nonetheless want to provide you whatever documents I have related to my work on the Commission.

Enclosed are all of the documents in my possession that I have identified as related to my work on the Commission. No documents that I have identified are being withheld for any reason although there are a few redactions. These redactions mostly relate to personal email addresses, personal telephone numbers, and other personal information. If you have any questions about any of the redactions please let me know.

I also understand that my office will be providing governmental records responsive to some of your requests next week but I wanted to provide the enclosed documents to you since they are not governmental records and therefore may not be included in the production from my office.
