Re: Right-to-Know Request

Dear Secretary Gardner,

This is a Right-to-Know request to the Secretary of State's Office pursuant to RSA 91-A by America Votes New Hampshire. America Votes NH works to ensure ballot access for all eligible voters.

Our request is for the following:

1. Any communication from the Secretary's office, including any staff, to or from any city or town clerk OR city or town Moderator dating back to January 1st 2014 including but not limited to letters or electronic mail.
2. Any communication from the Secretary's office, including any staff, to the Kansas Secretary of State Kobachs's office, including any staff, dating back to January 1st, 2014 including but not limited to letters or electronic mail.
3. Any payments made to Secretary of State Kobach, his office, or any other entity affiliated with Secretary Kobach dating back to January 1st, 2014 including but not limited to letters or electronic mail.
4. Any communication from the Secretary of State's Office, including any staff, between the NH Speaker of the House' office and the Secretary of State's office dating back to March 1st, 2016 including but not limited to letters or electronic mail.
5. Any communications between the Secretary of State's office, including any staff, and Dr. Alexander A. Schwarzmann dating back to March 1st 2016 including but not limited to letters of electronic mail.
6. Any communication from the Secretary of State's office, including any staff, relating to electronic or digital poll books dating back to March 1st, 2016 including but not limited to letters and electronic mail.
7. Any communication relating to complaints of lines or other polling place capacity issues from the 2012 or 2014 general elections and the 2016 Presidential Primary including but not limited to letters or electronic mail.

If produced, we request that these records be produced irrespective of their storage format; that is, that they be produced whether they are kept in tangible (hard copy) form or in an electronically-stored format. If any records are withheld or any portion redacted, we ask that you specify the reasons. Of course, we will also be accommodating with respect to your response time frame.

Thank you for your anticipated cooperation, and, again, I am happy to answer any questions you may have about our project.
