Craft a ~350 word storytelling project proposal:

- Start with a topic of interest inspired by the underlined statement above.
- Who are the stakeholders?
- How does this topic honor differences, deepen understanding, contemplate shared experience or reach across boundaries?
- How will you present this story(or stories)? Is a series of audio features? An engagement project centered around a facebook group? A visualization of the issue with companion stories?
- What skills of yours will this test? What will you need to learn to pull this project off? What scares you about this topic?

Feel free to present this as a bulleted list, a outline, a few paragraphs, whatever fits your project.

Make sure this is a topic you're prepared to spend your 14-week internship dedicated to (we may help you refine or tweak it if you're accepted to make it manageable if need be.)

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
