ROBERT E OLSEN

with the offense of **FELONY MURDER** in violation of O.C.G.A. 16-5-1(c) for the said accused person, in the County of DeKalb and State of Georgia, **on or about the 9th day of March, 2015**, while in the commission of the offense of Aggravated Assault, a felony, did cause the death of Anthony Hill, a human being, by shooting him with a firearm,

contrary to the laws of said State, the good order, peace and dignity thereof.

COUNT 2

The GRAND JURORS aforesaid, in the name of and on behalf of the citizens of the State of Georgia, charge and accuse

ROBERT E OLSEN

with the offense of **FELONY MURDER** in violation of O.C.G.A. 16-5-1(c) for the said accused person, in the County of DeKalb and State of Georgia, **on or about the 9th day of March, 2015**, while in the commission of the felony offense of Violation of Oath by a Public Officer as described in Count 4, did cause the death of Anthony Hill, a human being, by shooting him with a firearm,

contrary to the laws of said State, the good order, peace and dignity thereof.

COUNT 3

The GRAND JURORS aforesaid, in the name of and on behalf of the citizens of the State of Georgia, charge and accuse

ROBERT E OLSEN

with the offense of **AGGRAVATED ASSAULT** in violation of O.C.G.A. 16-5-21 for the said accused person, in the County of DeKalb and State of Georgia, **on or about the 9th day of March, 2015**, did make an assault upon the person of Anthony Hill with a deadly weapon, to wit: by shooting him with a firearm,

contrary to the laws of said State, the good order, peace and dignity thereof.

COUNT 4

The GRAND JURORS aforesaid, in the name of and on behalf of the citizens of the State of Georgia, charge and accuse

ROBERT E OLSEN

with the offense of **VIOLATION OF OATH BY PUBLIC OFFICER** in violation of O.C.G.A. 16-10-1 for the said accused person, in the County of DeKalb and State of Georgia, **on or about the 9th day of March, 2015**, being a public officer with the DeKalb County Police Department, did willfully and intentionally violate the terms of his oath as prescribed by law, in that he did (in pertinent part) swear to

"support and defend the constitution of the United States of America and the constitution of the State of Georgia; that I will faithfully enforce the laws of the State of Georgia and the county of DeKalb; that I will faithfully perform all of the duties of my office, and that I will faithfully observe all the rules, orders and regulations of the DeKalb County Police Department.... I do further swear or affirm that, as a police officer, I will faithfully serve and protect, to the best of my ability, all citizens regardless of race, color, or creed. I accept the law enforcement code or canon of ethics as my standard of conduct while on or off duty and swear to faithfully abide by and defend the same"

and then did use deadly force upon the unarmed person of Anthony Hill by shooting him with a firearm, in violation of O.C.G.A. 17-4-20 (b) and the DeKalb County Police Department's Use of Force policy as contained in the Department's Employee Manual section 4-6,

contrary to the laws of said State, the good order, peace and dignity thereof.

COUNT 5

The GRAND JURORS aforesaid, in the name of and on behalf of the citizens of the State of Georgia, charge and accuse

ROBERT E OLSEN

with the offense of **MAKING A FALSE STATEMENT** in violation of O.C.G.A. 16-10-20 for the said accused person, in the County of DeKalb and State of Georgia, **on or about the 9th day of March, 2015**, knowingly and willfully make a false representation to DeKalb County Police Officer L. Anderson in the investigation into the shooting of Anthony Hill, a matter within the jurisdiction of the DeKalb County Police Department, a department of DeKalb County government, to wit: Defendant falsely claimed that the victim Anthony Hill physically assaulted him prior to the shooting by pounding on his (Defendant's) chest,

contrary to the laws of said State, the good order, peace and dignity thereof.

COUNT 6

The GRAND JURORS aforesaid, in the name of and on behalf of the citizens of the State of Georgia, charge and accuse

ROBERT E OLSEN

with the offense of **VIOLATION OF OATH BY PUBLIC OFFICER** in violation of O.C.G.A. 16-10-1 for the said accused person, in the County of DeKalb and State of Georgia, **on or about the 9th day of March, 2015**, being a public officer with the DeKalb County Police Department, did willfully and intentionally violate the terms of his oath as prescribed by law, in that he did swear (in pertinent part) to

"support and defend the constitution of the United States of America and the constitution of the State of Georgia; that I will faithfully enforce the laws of the State of Georgia and the county of DeKalb; that I will faithfully perform all of the duties of my office, and that I will faithfully observe all the rules, orders and regulations of the DeKalb County Police Department.... I do further swear or affirm that, as a police officer, I will faithfully serve and protect, to the best of my ability, all citizens regardless of race, color, or creed. I accept the law enforcement code or canon of ethics as my standard of conduct while on or off duty and swear to faithfully abide by and defend the same"

and then did make a false statement to Officer L. Anderson in an effort to fabricate a justification for the shooting of the unarmed Anthony Hill and in violation of O.C.G.A. 16-10-20 and DeKalb County Police Department truthfulness policy as contained in the Department's Employee Manual section 2-2.17, by falsely claiming that the victim physically assaulted the Defendant prior to the shooting by pounding on his (Defendant's) chest,

contrary to the laws of said State, the good order, peace and dignity thereof.
