Ahoy, WAMC land! 'Tis the season of dreidels, tinsel and TV ads that wish a 'sparkly day'. So we want to give you our own shiny star with some great programming during the holiday season.

It all kicks off on Monday December 9th at 7PM with the perennial favorite, *Hanukkah Lights 2012*, which features Hanukkah stories and memoirs written by acclaimed authors expressly for the show, as read by NPR's Susan Stamberg and Murray Horwitz. Then we'll continue to celebrate the Festival of Lights on Tuesday at 11AM with *Chanukah in Story and Song*. This hour-long Chanukah special is a celebration by The Western Wind performing Ladino songs of Spanish Jews, Yiddish melodies of Eastern Europe and modern Israeli tunes, and is hosted by Leonard Nimoy.

We'll get a little raucous with *All Songs Considered for the Holidays* at noon. Host Bob Boilen and friends will trade holiday cheer and snarky barbs while bringing you the best holiday songs from new and emerging breakout bands.

A Christmas Celtic Sojourn will tantalize your ears between 2PM and 4PM. Host Brian O'Donovan has assembled some of the best musicians, singers, and dancers imaginable from around the Celtic world, and beyond!

And it's not over yet, folks! We'll bring you a Kwanza celebration at 11AM on December 26th, and our annual live show *Toast of the Nation* on New Year's

Eve/Night, as well as *Live from Vienna!* the following morning.
