Well, folks, it's a new year with endless possibilities ahead. Some of us watched the ball drop in Times Square, some rang in 2014 with friends and family, while others (like myself) decided it's too hard to stay up that late and greeted the new year sometime after sunrise.

There are so many great things happening at the station, I don't know where to begin. One of the most exciting is that you can now text-to-pledge. That's right, aside from being able to call in your pledge or make it on-line, you now do it from your phone. We also have some special premiums just for the text-to-pledge members. You can find out more on how to do it via our webpage. The times, they are a-changin', and we're keeping up with them. Don't forget, we have our nifty mobile website for your smartphone, whether it's an iPhone or Android. You can stream the station, select specific news stories or interviews, and check out our schedule so you know what specials are coming up.

Speaking of which... I want to remind you of the two new programs that I told you about last month. The first is the amazing music program, American Routes, on Tuesdays at 8 PM. It's a weekly two-hour program presenting a broad range of American music — blues and jazz, gospel and soul, old-time country and rockabilly, Cajun and zydeco, Tejano and Latin, roots rock and pop, avant-garde and classical. The second program is the return of Vox Pop with Food Fridays! We'll have lots of special guests to talk food with you.

amount of money for the station.

The WAMC Locked Box will have more money in it than at any time in history.

NPR will come under fire from station managers and from the public over the woman who reads the network underwriting announcements. The NPR brass will counter that they did a two year national search and found the "best announcer in the country."

NPR will announce that it is going to raise money directly from listeners, something that it isn't supposed to do.

WAMC will alter its smoking policy. A blue box right next to the street will be the only place smoking will be allowed.

A wonderful listener will donate an enormous amount of money to the station for its First Amendment Fund. She'll say, "I just can't stand what is happening in this country. What with all the spying and the control of information, WAMC is out there telling the truth and letting all sides have their say. Furthermore, you can't have democracy unless you have information and no one does it better than WAMC."

Her gift will be matched by a man who says, "'I've listened to public radio stations all over the country and I have never heard anything like WAMC."

The Berkshire Ramblers will be discovered and invited by Arlo Guthrie to appear at his annual Carnegie Hall Concert.

A new organization of conservative talked show hosts will try to pressure WAMC to carry Limbaugh, O'Reilly and several more of those types.
