## Sending a Signal

There is, of course, a tremendous sense of relief and gratitude at the end of every fund drive. The end means that a group of people, dedicated to preserving something precious, have done it again. I keep thinking of the early American spirit of raising barns together. There is something splendid about a government that tries to help. Nevertheless, in the end governments are too often controlled by politicians who are primarily dedicated to preserving and maintaining personal power. My friend Eliot Spitzer has said time and again those politicians who give you money too often believe that the people's money is their own to play politics with. We know that the Republicans in the House of Representatives have voted to stop funding the Corporation for Public Broadcasting that group that gives out the money to public radio and television stations. We know why they are doing that. They want to control the message.

No matter, when we prevail in a fund drive, we are sending a signal to those politicians who would

defund NPR, CPB and WAMC. That message is that like the colonists of old, we will band together and find a way to keep things going. Incredibly, we persevered. A million dollars is a great deal of money and we never would have achieved that monumental goal unless a lot of individuals and families decided not to walk away, or more affirmatively to put something toward the common effort. We heard from Republicans and Democrats and independents. Each person has a favorite show and would dedicate a pledge to keep it going. As the money comes in, we read each and every message about what people like, what they don't like and what new things they'd like to see.

When the snow birds come back from Florida or Arizona, they call in with messages about just how good WAMC is compared to the stations they have been listening to down south or out West. Now, with the option of listening on line at WAMC.org or to the WAMC "App.," more and more people tell us how they listen all year no matter where they are. In the last drive we heard from China and Australia.

People always ask me what we are going to do in a coming fund drive. I always say that despite any planning we may do, that drives take on their own character. It's all serendipitous. In this fund drive there is no question that the crank radios we were offering as premiums took off like a great bird. We started with just a few but as it became clear that a lot of people wanted them our Dona Frank kept reaching out for more. I was telling the truth that in the beginning we just had a few of them but with each new lot the pressure was on to find more. Finally, a listener called in and said, "Alan is always saying how few are left. Sounds to me like the few are having babies."

Then there was the wonderful generosity from Tanglewood and SPAC. The tickets that they gave us were tickets that they could have sold themselves but they know a good partnership when they see one and they were there.

We set a record this time but don't let anyone tell you that this is ever going to be easy. Nothing worthwhile ever is. I feel a tremendous amount of connection when I am sitting there, depending on you to make it happen. "Mr. Big," gave us a tremendous \$25,000 match that produced a record \$75,000 morning. Then Eliot Spitzer came up with a similar test. Both gave us two dollars for every dollar that you donated and then a wonderful philanthropic group with deep ties in the Capital region gave us a whopping match that helped end the drive. It is always amazing how these big matches inspire everyone to give.

When the drive is over it takes me a couple of weeks to recover. As I write this we are about a week and a half out of the drive and I am so tired that I can't pick my head up. So, thanks to all of you for everything you've done to keep the fragile experiment alive. I know why you do it but I am so proud of all of us that I could burst. - Alan


