FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF ANSWERING THE MAIL

As you may imagine, we receive a lot of mail at WAMC – here are a few of our listeners' recent questions.

WHY DO YOU PLAY THE BBC NEWS IN THE MIDDLE OF THE ROUNDTABLE PANEL?

The answer to this one is that when we redesigned the program, we decided that the panel would be a good transition between the hard NPR news of the day and the marvelous regional programming heard on the Roundtable. The BBC certainly offers a perspective different from that of NPR. Since I get up and leave for work at 2:30 in the morning, I get to enjoy the Beeb, which certainly gives us news from the rest of the world in a way that NPR doesn't. The BBC part of the show is only a few minutes and offers a little diversity. And frankly, since we design much of the Roundtable on the fly, it gives us a chance to discuss what we are going to talk about next. We think it works and for those who would like a little more panel discussion and a little less news, I beg for your patience on the matter.

WHY DID YOU PRE-EMPT GARRISON KEILLOR THE OTHER DAY TO PLAY AN NPR PROGRAM GIVING THE RESULTS OF A PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY?

Talk about why my hair is growing gray! This certainly puts us between the rock and the proverbial hard place. No matter what we might do, we will get criticism. HOW COME YOU CONTINUE TO PLAY THE METROPOLITAN OPERA WHEN SO MANY PEOPLE CALL IN DURING THE FUND DRIVE AND TELL US HOW MUCH THEY HATE IT?

Well, the opera has always been a big part of WAMC. Okay, so I don't like it but there are many who really do. I try to do my shopping during that time or maybe even write columns like this one. The point here is that a great public radio station like this one doesn't stick to a single format. I will admit that when they broadcast an interminable opera that cancels out the news on both ends of the program, I grow very distressed and have been known to let the people at the Met know of my displeasure. In fact, when I get the contract from the Met I have been known to sign it and then add the comment, "Signed under protest." I've been doing that for many years and no one has ever written back. WHY DO YOU DO A VOX POP PROGRAM IN WHICH PEOPLE ARE ALLOWED TO CALL IN AND WHY DO YOU TAKE SO MANY E-MAILS DURING YOUR MORNING PANEL?

You can't have it both ways. People who say that we should have more voices on the air are allowed to call in, to write, and to let us hear from them on the "Listener's Comment Line." That's what it's all about and I wouldn't have it any other way.

MARCH PROGRAM NOTES

March first marks the start of the spring solar outage week. A solar or sun transit outage is an electromagnetic phenomenon wherein a station downlink is temporarily unable to receive a satellite signal due to interference from the sun as it passes behind the satellite. This is a fancy way of saying that we will temporarily lose any live audio feed off of satellite for about 6 minutes around 2 p.m. in our region. Due to the outage, we have to make a slight change to our programming schedule. The outages in our region will take place during the NPR newscast that airs within Vox Pop. As a result, we will be skipping the 2:01 p.m.-2:04 p.m. NPR Newscast and going right into our local regional newscast during the first week of March. We will return to our normal schedule the following week.

WAMC and NPR will be providing special coverage of Super Tuesday at 8 p.m. on March first. Ari Shapiro and Rachel Martin will anchor the coverage. Coming up on March 30th, The American Roots series at the Linda presents: songs from the Alan Lomax Library of Congress Music Collection performed by The Down Hill Strugglers, The Four O'Clock Flowers & Meredith Axelrod. This performance will be presented as a special, live, direct to air broadcast of our Live at the Linda radio program. The show will be hosted by local music legend, Michael Eck! You can be part of the live studio audience or you can join us in spirit by tuning in to this special event on the radio 8 p.m.-10 p.m.. HERE'S YOUR RETIREMENT "TO DO" LIST

During your working years, you always have plenty of things you need to do and barely enough time to get them done. While retirement will certainly afford you more free time, the fact is that once you decide to retire, you'll still have quite a bit you'll need to tackle right before and immediately after your retirement date to ensure you keep your retirement finances in order.

So before you hit the golf course or the beach, you may want to tick off a few items on this list. Here are some things you'll need to do once you hit retirement:

- **APPLY FOR MEDICARE.** When you're first eligible for Medicare, you have a seven-month initial enrollment period to sign up for Part A and/or Part B. For example, if you're eligible at age 65, you can sign up during the seven-month period that begins three

months before the month you turn 65, includes the month you turn 65, and ends three months after the month you turn 65. As long as you or your spouse worked for 10 years or more in the U.S., you won't have to pay a monthly fee for Part A – the hospital insurance component of Medicare – but you will have a deductible. For Medicare Part B – which covers outpatient care – you'll typically need to pay a monthly fee, a deductible and 20 percent of the Medicare-approved amount for some types of care. You'll also need to determine whether you need to add any supplemental insurance.

- **DECIDE WHEN TO TAKE SOCIAL SECURITY.** You don't have to wait until retirement before you start collecting Social Security, but if you accept benefits while you are working, your monthly checks may be reduced, at least until you reach your "full" retirement age (which will likely be 66 or 67). You can start collecting Social

Security as early as age 62, but each year you wait, your benefits will increase by about 8 percent until they top out at age 70. So, in deciding when to take Social Security, you'll have to factor in your projected longevity and other sources of income, such as your IRA and 401(k).

- **REVIEW YOUR INVESTMENT PORTFOLIO.** As you enter your retirement years, you may need to adjust your investment mix. You could spend two, or even three, decades in retirement, so you will still need a reasonable percentage of growth-oriented investments to help you stay ahead of inflation. However, at this point in your life, you may also need to increase your holdings in bonds and other income-producing vehicles, such as dividend-paying stocks.

- **CHOOSE AN APPROPRIATE WITHDRAWAL STRATEGY.** You'll have to start withdrawals from your traditional IRA and your 401(k) or similar employer-sponsored plan once you reach age 70 ½, but you don't have to wait



that long. (A Roth IRA has no required minimum distribution requirements; you can keep the money in your account for as long as you choose.) In any case, though, you will eventually need to tap into your retirement plans – but how much should you withdraw each year? The answer depends on a variety of factors, including your age and the other sources of income you have available. Obviously, your ultimate goal is to withdraw enough to enjoy a comfortable retirement – but not so much that you run the risk of outliving your resources. A professional financial advisor can help you choose a withdrawal strategy that’s appropriate for your needs.

- **CREATE OR FINALIZE YOUR ESTATE PLANS.** If you haven’t already drawn up your estate plans – your will, living trust, power of attorney, etc. – now is definitely the time. And even if you have already created these plans, you may need to revise them based on changes in your life, such as divorce or remarriage. You’ll need to work with a legal professional to ensure your estate plans are suitable for your individual situation.

These aren’t the only steps you’ll need to take to make sure your finances are in order, but addressing these points can give you a good start toward reaching the retirement lifestyle you’ve always envisioned.

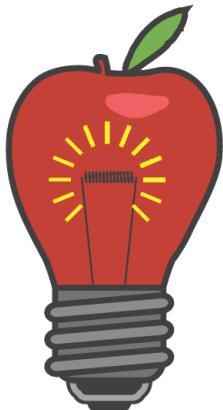
