

<b>ORDER</b>		
1. The head of <u>CMPD</u> (Custodial Law Enforcement Agency) is ordered to provide to the Court a copy of the Law Enforcement Agency Recording identified in the attached Petition. If the Law Enforcement Agency Recording identified in the attached Petition does not exist, the Law Enforcement Agency shall provide to the Court an explanation on the Transmittal of Law Enforcement Agency Recording form.		
2. The copy of the Law Enforcement Agency Recording shall be provided to Superior Court judicial assistant located in the Judges' Office on the 9 <sup>th</sup> Floor of the Mecklenburg County Courthouse on or before <u>8-30-17</u> , along with a list of all Law Enforcement Agency personnel whose image or voice is in the recording. In the event the custodial Law Enforcement Agency is unable to identify all voices or images of Law Enforcement Agency personnel in the recording, the head of the Law Enforcement Agency shall identify to the Court where in the recording the unidentifiable voice or image appears. The copy of the Law Enforcement Agency Recording and the list of all Law Enforcement Agency personnel whose image or voice is in the recording shall be delivered to Superior Court judicial assistant in a sealed envelope with the Transmittal form attached to the outside of the sealed envelope. The custodial Law Enforcement Agency shall provide the recording to the Court in a file format supported by the NC Administrative Office of the Courts or shall provide the means to conduct an in camera review of the recording.		
3. The copy of the Law Enforcement Agency Recording and the list of all Law Enforcement Agency personnel whose image or voice is in the recording delivered to the Court pursuant to this Order shall not be open to inspection or copy by any person except to the Superior Court Judge conducting the hearing, until ordered released or disclosed by the presiding Superior Court Judge.		
4. The head of the custodial Law Enforcement Agency is hereby ordered upon receipt of this Order, to give Notice of the Petition and Hearing to any Law Enforcement Agency personnel whose image or voice is in the recording and to the head of that person's employing Law Enforcement Agency. In the event the Law Enforcement Agency is unable to give Notice to all Law Enforcement Agency personnel whose image or voice is in the recording, the Law Enforcement Agency shall state the same in the Certificate of Service and provide an explanation as to why Notice was not given, on the personnel list to be included with the copy of the Law Enforcement Agency recording.

I am seeking video related to protests and demonstrations following the Sept. 20, 2016 police shooting of Keith Lamont Scott. The activity followed the shooting and continued intermittently through Sept. 24.

We considered seeking the total video available. But after consultation with CMPD, we were informed that there were "boiling points" at different locations we had asked about, and, based upon that consultation with CMPD, our request is for the following videos from the following locations and times:

– Helicopter/Old Concord Rd., 9/20, 22:01 to 22:08 (1<sup>st</sup> part of Video); 2<sup>nd</sup> part 22:38 to 23:01. (Footage from CMPD helicopter.)

– I/85 Protest, 9/21, 01:56 to 02:14. (Traffic camera footage from WT Harris, big crowd on Interstate.)

– Trade and Tryon, 9/21, 16:42 to 17:03. (Large group, non-violent protest.)

– Epicenter, 9/21, 19:47 to 20:04. (Thick crowd moving at rapid pace leaving Epicenter and then coming back.)

– Law Enforcement Center, 9/21, 19:57 to 20:20. (In front of police station, Trade and Caldwell streets, a group moving from the LEC toward the Transit Center.)

– Omni, 9/21, 20:28 to 20:39. (Large group outside Omni.)

– Transit Area, 9/21, 2 separate videos, 1<sup>st</sup> – 23:32 to 23:56 and 2<sup>nd</sup> is 23:57 to 00:01.

– Marshall Park, 9/24, 13:38 to 13:59. (Organized protest.)
