Thank you for your interest in volunteering at NEPR – we look forward to having you as part of our team.

There are several ways to volunteer.

Clerical Work: The NEPR Development Department often needs volunteers for small clerical projects including transcription throughout the year.

Mailings: Several large mailings are done in house every year and NEPR always needs help with stuffing and labeling.

Special Event Ushering: Volunteers are needed to usher at special events throughout the year.

Special Event Help: Volunteers are needed to help out in many ways at various events throughout the year, including pub nights, the Arts & Humanities Awards Gala, etc.

Thank You Calls: After every fund drive, NEPR calls to thank every new donor (and possibly others) to the station for making a first time contribution. This additional “touch” is incredibly effective in making longtime donors out of first time contributors. Volunteers are needed to make these scripted calls after each drive.

Tours: We offer tours to the public at our downtown Springfield headquarters. Trained volunteers will be needed to lead tours of the building.

Fund Drive Supervising: Although new security protocols require NEPR to make changes to its fund drive volunteer room, we will need fund drive supervisors to help collect numbers from the web and names of people to thank for pitchers during the drive.
