- II. Description of recruitment initiatives taken since June 1, 2005.

Career Fairs: In an effort to disseminate throughout the community information regarding Interlochen Public Radio hiring efforts, the station has participated in the Michigan Association of Broadcasters’ Great Lakes Broadcasting Conference and Career Expo on March 13-15, 2006. IPR was represented by station personnel capable of making hiring decisions. At these events, station personnel presented general information about the station and offered specific opportunities to be added to the recruitment notification list.

Internship Program: Interlochen Public Radio operates an internship program to train members of the community in radio hosting, production and reporting. Three persons have participated from June 2005 to May 2006 to develop and enhance recording, production, and interviewing techniques.
