BATTERY REPORT---OFFICER JASON LYTLE #115

On Friday 09/25/15 at 1026 hours, 1057 hours, I was dispatched to room [REDACTED] Knoblach hall to the report of a student and professor in a fight.

On arrival I was flagged down by the caller, student [REDACTED], who stated that he was just battered by a professor after his class.

[REDACTED] was being very loud to the point that I could not understand him, so we moved to an empty room 103. [REDACTED] stated that he is taking a [REDACTED] [REDACTED] believes that [REDACTED] is grading him lower than the rest of the class for doing the same quality of work. [REDACTED] stated that he received a paper back today that was graded harder than others in his class and decided to meet [REDACTED] at his office after class.

[REDACTED] stated that while in the office, he asked [REDACTED] if he had a "vendetta" against him and he said that [REDACTED] responded "no." [REDACTED] asked [REDACTED] why does everyone else in the class get a higher grade than him while he is quoting the same material [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] said that he did not have time to talk with him and brushed past [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that upon leaving the office, [REDACTED] stated "this is ridiculous". [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] told him to turn around and say that to me like a man. [REDACTED] stated that he turned around and [REDACTED] "thrusts" his forearm extremely hard into his throat. [REDACTED] stated that he could not breathe and remembers his head hitting the wall behind him. [REDACTED] stated that after [REDACTED] struck him in the throat, [REDACTED] got into a boxing stance and began to bob and weave as if in a boxing match. [REDACTED] felt as if [REDACTED] was going to attempt to punch him, so he defended himself and threw a punch and landed it somewhere on [REDACTED] face. After the punch landed, [REDACTED] stated that he ran out of the room and yelled for someone to call the police. [REDACTED] remembers coming up to another student asking them to call the police, and the unidentified student stated that it was not his responsibility. [REDACTED] said that he ran to room [REDACTED] and called the police from there.

As I was speaking to [REDACTED] I could not see any redness or injury to his neck area.

[REDACTED] believes that [REDACTED] has it out for him for some reason. [REDACTED] has complained to the dean in Stipes hall in the past about how [REDACTED] has been picking on him and giving him the lowest grade possible.

[REDACTED] stated that he does not feel safe and wishes to press charges.

I explained to [REDACTED] that I would need to get both sides of the story and that other officers are speaking with [REDACTED] at this time.

I met with Cpl ANDERSON #119, who spoke with [REDACTED] (SEE SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT) who

had a different story about how the battery occurred.

I explained to [REDACTED] that based on both sides of the incident, I was unable to determine who was the aggressor and due to there not being any witnesses, I would be forwarding this report to the States Attorney's office for review.

Cpl ANDERSON and myself met with the [REDACTED] and it was determined that [REDACTED] could not return to class until the issue is settled and he would not be docked attendance points and would be given assignments and notes via e-mail.

I met with [REDACTED] again and explained that in the mean time, he is not to come to class all next week until this issue is resolved. I told [REDACTED] that he would not be docked attendance points and that he would be getting his assignment via e-mail.

[REDACTED] completed a written statement.

On 09/25/15 at about 1100 hrs. Ofc. LYTLE and I, Cpl. Ted ANDERSON, responded to Knoblauch Hall for a fight between a student and professor where the parties were separated. Ofc. LYTLE spoke with the student, [REDACTED] while I met with the [REDACTED]

I spoke with [REDACTED] in the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was sitting in a chair with a bag of ice on his right cheek. [REDACTED] stated that after class he went down to [REDACTED] followed him to the office and accosted him. [REDACTED] accused [REDACTED] of treating him unfairly and disrespectfully. [REDACTED] then moved into the hallway with [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] continued to claim he was being treated unfairly. [REDACTED] then told [REDACTED] he was "nothing but and old man, you're ridiculous." [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] putting his forearm up. [REDACTED] then struck [REDACTED] in the right side of his face with his closed left fist. When asked, [REDACTED] stated he did not believe he made contact with [REDACTED] when he stepped up to him.

[REDACTED] completed a written statement. I asked [REDACTED] if he wanted to press charges against [REDACTED] for battery. [REDACTED] stated he did not, but felt [REDACTED] and some regulation from the University. I took pictures of his cheek which was significantly swollen.

[REDACTED] was later told the report would be forwarded to the States Attorney, as well as Student Judicial Programs.
