**South Florida's PBS Station WLRN premieres
"Oceans of Pink," a new one-hour documentary that tells the
story of how dragon boat racing became a fast-growing
sport among breast cancer survivors across Florida.**

Miami, FL – July 8, 2016 – On Friday, July 29th, 2016, WLRN will broadcast its new television documentary *Oceans of Pink*. This one-hour original WLRN production is produced by local filmmaker Shirley Ravachi and highlights the explosive growth of dragon boat racing among breast cancer survivors across Florida, and the growing participation in the sport of Hispanic women who are often at greater risk from the disease. The film follows the efforts of Miami boat leader and breast cancer survivor Kim Bonomo to expand the movement with new teams throughout the state and her campaign to make Florida the host of the Fourth International Participatory Dragon Boat Festival.

It's an emotional journey that tells the stories of several Latina women whose struggles with the disease became more desperate because they did not discover they were ill until their cancer had reached an advanced stage. Their stories speak to a widespread problem in the Hispanic population where women tend to seek breast scans much later than other groups. The stories build to the international race event in Sarasota, the first of its kind in the United States, where thousands of survivors from around the globe celebrate the sisterhood of dragon boaters who have found in the sport a common community of support that is helping women overcome the challenges of cancer.

WLRN will hold a complimentary community screening event on Thursday, July 28th, 2016, starting at 6 p.m. at the Victor E. Clarke Education Center. The center is located at South Miami Hospital, 6200 SW 73 Street, Miami, FL 33143. Seating is limited, please RSVP no later than Friday, July 22nd at www.oceansofpink.org.

The screening is an informal event with doors opening for a reception at 6:00 p.m. and the film presentation at 7:00 p.m., followed by a Q & A session with the film producer and featured members of the only breast cancer survivors' dragon boat racing team in Miami.
