## WLRN News Wins Three Edward R. Murrow National Awards

Miami, FL –June 21, 2016 – WLRN News has won three recognitions in the latest edition of the National Edward R. Murrow Awards. The Edward R. Murrow Awards are issued by the Radio Television Digital News Association (RTDNA) to honor "outstanding achievements in electronic journalism" since 1971. News organizations from all 50 states submit their best work for this competition.

RTDNA has announced the winners of the 2016 National Edward R. Murrow Awards, which recognize outstanding work produced by radio, television and online news organizations around the world.

<u>The Migration Maze</u>, a joint project with The Miami Herald, was recognized as the **best Audio News** Series in the Large Market Radio Station Category.

<u>Shark Attack On The Beach! Footvolley's Popularity Taking Off In Florida, the U.S.</u>, won the award to the **best Audio Sports Reporting in the Large Market Radio Station Category.** 

WLRN was also recognized along with fellow public media stations <u>WUSF</u> and <u>WMFE</u> for its work in the <u>Health News Florida</u> project. This partnership received the National Murrow Award for its website on the **Small Online News Organization (Audio) category.** 

WLRN News had already won <u>6 awards in the regional edition</u> of the Edward R. Murrow awards, announced last April.

RTDNA says they received more than 4,300 entries, setting an all-time record for the fourth year in a row. The winners will be recognized at the RTDNA Edward R. Murrow Awards Gala at Gotham Hall in New York City on October 10.
