DEFINIS We exited our vehicle and made contact with Bryant in the public roadway directly in front of 142 Mather Street. We observed that Bryant was drinking from a 12 Ounce Seagram's wine cooler bottle, a clear violation of Hartford City Ordinance 4-3; Public Drinking.									
Detective Salkeld requested that Bryant provide him with his identification. As Bryant was removing his wallet from his back pocket Detective Salkeld observed that he had a large pocket knife clipped to his right pants pocket. For officer safety Detective Salkeld removed the knife from Bryant's pocket, and placed it on the roof of our vehicle. I asked Bryant if he had any additional weapons on his person as I intended to conduct an exterior pat down of him for officer safety. Bryant stated that he did not, but appeared to be alarmed by this question. I asked that Bryant place his hands on the trunk lid of our vehicle, and I began to conduct the exterior pat down of his person. As I began to feel the contents of Bryant's front right coat pocket through the coat I felt a heavy weighted item which I believed to be consistent with the weight of the firearm. I immediately stopped the pat down and attempted to detain Bryant in handcuffs.									
Bryant immediately pushed off of the rear of our vehicle and started to run south towards Brook Street. I was able to grab Bryant by the back of his coat, and slow him down as he continued to run south. Detective Salkeld ran to us and was able to grab Bryant in a bear hug around his waist. Bryant began to violently swing his elbows and throw punches towards Detective Salkeld and I. I was able to avoid being punch by Bryant, and struck him one time in the face with a closed right fist in an attempt to stun and disorient him. This strike was ineffective and Bryant continued to violently throw punches and elbow strikes. Bryant was able to partially break free from Detective Salkeld's grip as I attempted to convey over the PDPATROL I frequency that we were involved in an active fight. Bryant struck Detective Salkeld in the nose with an elbow, causing him to immediately lose his balance as well as partial consciousness. Detective Salkeld suffered a large cut on the bridge of his nose which was bleeding excessively.

DETAILS

I removed my department issued Taser X-26 from its holster and fired it at Bryant, striking him in his back with both prongs. The Taser cycled for five seconds, but was ineffective as Bryant had a thick gray leather coat on. Bryant began to run east on Mather Street while shedding the coat and leaving it in the roadway in the area of 136 Mather Street. I began to chase Bryant on foot while conveying over the PDPATROL 1 frequency that I actively was in a foot chase. Bryant ran north through the rear yard of 136 Mather Street, and then west through a broken portion of a stockade fence. I was in close proximity to Bryant the entire time as he ran north through another broken stockade fence and wound up in the rear yard of 154 Brook Street.

Bryant lost his balance and fell to the ground two times in the rear yard of 154 Brook Street, causing cuts and scrapes to his knees and palms. I changed the cartridge of my Taser X-26 and ordered that Bryant "Stop" or that I would "Tase" him. Bryant ignored my verbal commands, and was trying to get back on his feet as I again deployed my Taser X-26 at him, striking him with both of the probes in his chest area. I allowed the Taser X-26 to cycle for five seconds. Bryant was able to get back on his feet and was now facing me in the rear yard of 154 Brook Street. Bryant with both fists clenched in a fighting posture began to move towards me as he intended to attack me. I was within only a few feet of Bryant and was still holding the Taser X-26 in my right hand. I struck Bryant in the head with the Taser X-26, using it as an emergency impact device in an attempt to gain compliance. This strike caused a cut to Bryant's head which immediately began to bleed.

Detective Salkeld who ran the same route as Bryant and I arrived at my location at this time. Detective Salkeld again grabbed Bryant in a bear hug type maneuver. Detective Salkeld was holding Bryant from behind, and attempted to take him to the ground but was unable to as Bryant continued to fight and try to escape. I holstered my Taser X-26, and removed my baton from its holster. A large crowd began to form in the front of 154 Brook Street, and were observing what was taking place. Detective Salkeld pleaded with the crowd for help as we were unable to successfully place Bryant in handcuffs. The crowd became very angry and was yelling threats towards Detective Salkeld and I.

DETAILS
Fearing that the crowd may attempt to attack Detective Salkeld and I struck Bryant in his left thigh with my baton in an attempt to bring him to the ground to gain compliance. Bryant refused to go to the ground and I continued to shout loud verbal commands to "get on the ground" and "stop resisting." Bryant ignored these commands, and as a result I struck him two more times, giving the same commands before each strike. Bryant finally fell to the ground with Detective Salkeld on his back. Bryant still refused to place his hands behind his back, until assisting Officer's arrived on scene and helped in securing him in double locked handcuffs. Bryant began to complain that he couldn't see as there was a large amount of blood on his face from both his injuries and Detective Salkeld's. Before Detective Salkeld left to seek his own medical treatment, he wiped the blood from Bryant's face so that he was able to again see.

Bryant's gray leather jacket was located in the roadway directly in front of 136 Mather Street by Officer Antuna. Located in the front left coat pocket of the gray leather jacket was (4) clear knotted plastic bags each containing a powder substance, and (3) clear knotted plastic bags each containing a rock like substance. Through our training and experience this was immediately recognized as both street level packaged powder cocaine, and street level packaged crack cocaine that was individually packaged for street level sales. A NIK field test was later conducted on a small portion of the powder substance as well as the rock like substance by Officer Antuna, which showed a positive presumptive reaction for cocaine in both instances.

A search of Bryant's person was conducted incidental to arrest, and I located in his front right pocket the above listed \$353.00 U.S. Currency (13 x \$20.00, 5 x \$10.00, 5 x \$5.00, 4 x \$2.00). The US Currency was separated in multi-denominations and was believed to be the proceeds of illegal drug sales as Bryant stated that he was currently unemployed, and did not have a legitimate source of income. The above listed \$353.00 U.S. Currency was later counted and was then seized pending asset forfeiture. Bryant was provided with a Seized Property Receipt (HPD Form 11) as proof of the money seizure. Bryant did not possess any item such as pipes, straws, or other instruments that may be used to consume either of the suspected powder or crack cocaine.

 At this time Samuel Bryant (DOB 4/1/81) was found to be in violation of Hartford City Ordinance 4-3; Public Drinking, and the following Connecticut General Statutes, 53a-167a; Interfering with Police, 53a-167c; Assault on Police, 53a-60; Assault in the Second Degree, 53a-117; Criminal Mischief in the Third Degree, 21a-279a; Possession of Narcotics, 21a-277(b); Possession of Narcotics with Intent to Sell, and 21a-278a(b); Possession of Narcotics with Intent to Sell within 1500' Feet of a Drug Free School Zone.

The above listed (4) clear knotted plastic bags each containing a powder substance, (3) clear knotted plastic bags each containing a rock like substance, \$353.00 U.S. Currency (13 x \$20.00, 5 x \$10.00, 5 x \$5.00, 4 x \$2.00), and Taser X-26 (Serial Number X00-565606) were transported to 50 Jennings Road where they were sealed as evidence by unit 240 Sergeant Rirkauiski. The evidence was submitted to the Hartford Police Department Property by Officer Kutchoy (HPD Property Receipt # AA 127298). The above listed (1) Black, red, green "Cucci" bifold wallet with miscellaneous cards, and (1) "L.G" cell phone (broken screen) were submitted to the Hartford Police Department Property Room for safe keeping as they were personal effects of Bryant.

The above listed 1999 Honda Accord (Connecticut Registration 8APLJ1) was parked in the private driveway of 154 Mather Street. The vehicle had blood along the drivers side of the vehicle as well as small scuffs and scratches which may have been a result of the incident.

DETAILS
 On Sunday, June 28, 2015, at approximately 1900 hours, Officers B. Salkeld and R. Fogg were involved in an altercation while attempting to take a party into custody. During the struggle, Officer Salkeld sustained an injury to his nose which was later treated at a local medical facility. The following day, I was asked by Sergeant O'Hare of the Hartford Police Department's Intelligence Division to respond to the area of 139 Mather Street (the incident location) and attempt to locate any and all video that may have captured the incident. I canvassed both neighborhood markets at the intersection of Brook and Mather Streets with negative results. The markets are approximately 100 feet south of the incident location. I additionally conducted a canvass of 139 Mather Street and all adjacent buildings, in an attempt to locate any individuals who may have captured the incident via cell phone video. This additionally yielded negative results. I left my contact information with several individuals who stated that they would contact me if any additional information would surface.

If I am contacted by anyone regarding the incident, I will follow-up with an additional supplement. Nothing further at this time.
