DETAILS <p>On June 4th, 2016, at approximately 2058 hours, Officer Barone advised the Patrol 2 dispatcher he was attempting to stop a stolen vehicle in the Brookfield Street area and had lost the vehicle. Officer Barone gave a description of the vehicle as a 2015 Toyota Camry bearing CT registration AC63521. Approximately 15 to 20 minutes later, Detective Pillai stated he was following the vehicle west on Ward Street towards Affleck Street. Detective Pillai advised the stolen vehicle turned north on Affleck Street and was in heavy vehicular traffic on Affleck Street. Detectives and uniformed officers approached the stolen vehicle on foot. At that point officers advised dispatch the operator was ramming several police vehicles and a detective had been struck by the stolen vehicle. A vehicle pursuit followed into West Hartford, where at one point a West Hartford Officer deployed stop sticks and deflated all four of the stolen vehicles tires. I followed from a distance at the rear of a large contingency of marked vehicles as the stolen vehicle traveled east on Flatbush Avenue from Quaker Lane South in West Hartford. Eventually marked units managed to stop the vehicle in the area of 800 Flatbush Avenue after being completely disabled. As I walked to the scene Officer Fogg approached me looking for sanitizer and stated the passenger (Emilio Diaz) in the stolen vehicle had spit blood in his face and he believed blood may have possibly been spat into his eye by the suspect.</p> <p>I approached Diaz who was handcuffed and kneeling and covered in blood on his upper body, face and head, as he was bleeding from a large laceration on the front of his forehead that was dripping onto his face/mouth area, which he was spitting. I also detected a strong distinct odor of PCP emanating from Diaz which usually involves violent behavior. Diaz was spitting out blood out of his mouth towards me. I told Diaz to stop spitting blood and to lay down prone, or I would force him down, which he refused to comply. Not being in possession of latex gloves, I used my right foot forcefully onto the lower back side of Diaz's head, and forced him to the ground. Diaz momentarily went down but still wouldn't lay prone, however he stopped spitting blood. Based on my training and experience, the smell of PCP coming from Diaz, along with his mannerisms and violent behavior, was consistent with a person being under the influence of PCP. Officers that had retrieved latex gloves returned and assisted EMS putting Diaz onto a stretcher and into an ambulance.</p>
