INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. "Documents and records" refers to all written or graphic matter, however produced or reproduced, or to any other tangible permanent record, and, without limitation, including, among other things, all letters, correspondence, communications (including email and emailed attachments), records, memoranda, minutes, notes, summaries, telephone records, books, schedules, reports, studies, appraisals, analyses, lists, interviews, books of account, telegrams, notes and minutes of meetings, interoffice communications, results of investigations, working papers, computer data, papers similar to any of the foregoing and other writings of every kind of description (whether or not actually used, and including drafts of all documents), and including not only originals of such documents but all photostatic, microfilmed or electronic copies in whatever form, and all sound records or electronic data compilations in whatever form.
- 2. "Communication" means any transmission or exchange of information between two or more persons, orally or in writing, and includes, without limitation, any conversation, contact or discussion, whether face-to-face or by means of telephone, telegraph, telex, electronic or other media, whether by chance or design.
- 3. A document within your "possession and control" includes not only those in your direct possession, but also those documents in the possession of another person or entity which you have the right to claim or possess, including any of the HPS officers, employees, agents, representatives, or attorneys. Accordingly, the HPS must designate, as "Custodian of Records," an officer or employee having personal and thorough knowledge of the HPS's records, who is to be responsible for the HPS's search for, and production of, responsive documents.
- 4. "Document(s) and Records" also includes all items which are subject to a claim of privilege. If any such documents or records are responsive to the subpoena, a privilege log must be produced as described in Paragraph 11.
- 5. Each page of any produced document should be identified in the lower right-hand corner by the initials "HPS" followed by a consecutive number, preferably marked in red or dark blue so that copies can be distinguished from original numbered documents.

- On the subpoena return date, the Custodian is to appear before the Grand Jury, produce the documents called for, and be examined concerning the HPS's production.
- 7. No document called for by this subpoena shall be destroyed, modified, redacted, removed, or otherwise made inaccessible to the Grand Jury.
- 8. The conjunctions "and" and "or" are to be construed interchangeably in the manner that gives this subpoena schedule the broadest reading.
- 9. The singular form of a word shall be construed to include within its meaning the plural form of the word and vice versa and the use of any tense of any verb shall be considered to also include all other tenses in a manner that gives this subpoena schedule the broadest reading.
- 10. If the HPS has knowledge of any document that would be responsive to this subpoena schedule but has been lost, destroyed, or discarded, it shall identify to the extent possible each such document and provide an explanation of the loss, destruction, or discarding (including identification of each person authorizing or having knowledge of the loss, destruction or discarding).
- 11. If the HPS withholds from production any responsive document on the ground of any privilege, it shall list each such document by date, type, addressee, author (and if different, the preparer and signatory), general subject matter, number of pages, paragraph of the subpoena to which the document is responsive, and indicated or known circulation, including the names and titles of all persons to whom the document, or a copy thereof, or any part thereof, was shown. In addition, it shall indicate the privilege asserted with respect to each such document in sufficient detail to facilitate a determination of the validity of the claim of privilege. Any subpoenaed document withheld as privileged, or for any other reason not produced to the Grand Jury, shall be maintained by the HPS in a secure location.
