Ranger Solar LLC (Ranger Solar) and MAP Royalty, Inc. (MAP) are pleased to present these five New England utility-scale photovoltaic on-peak solar energy generation projects to the Soliciting Parties. Ranger Solar / MAP is proposing these five individual ground mounted fixed tilt solar energy projects as separate bids. The proposed projects include:

- The 50 MW (scalable to up to 100 MW) Quinebaug Solar Project in Brooklyn and Canterbury, Connecticut,
- The 50 MW Sanford Airport Solar Project at the Sanford Seacoast Regional Airport in the City of Sanford, Maine,
- The 50 MW (scalable up to 80 MW) Farmington Solar Project in Farmington, Maine, and
- The 50 MW Chinook Solar Project (scalable to up to 80 MW) in Fitzwilliam, New Hampshire
- The 20 MW Enfield Solar Project in Enfield and Somers, Connecticut

Increased efficiency in solar panel production and inversion ratios, coupled with declining panel costs, have fostered a market where solar has become one of the cheapest forms of energy for the United States. Additionally, solar does not carry the same level of permitting risk as other types of renewables such as wind and hydro while keeping the jobs and economic benefits within the region.
